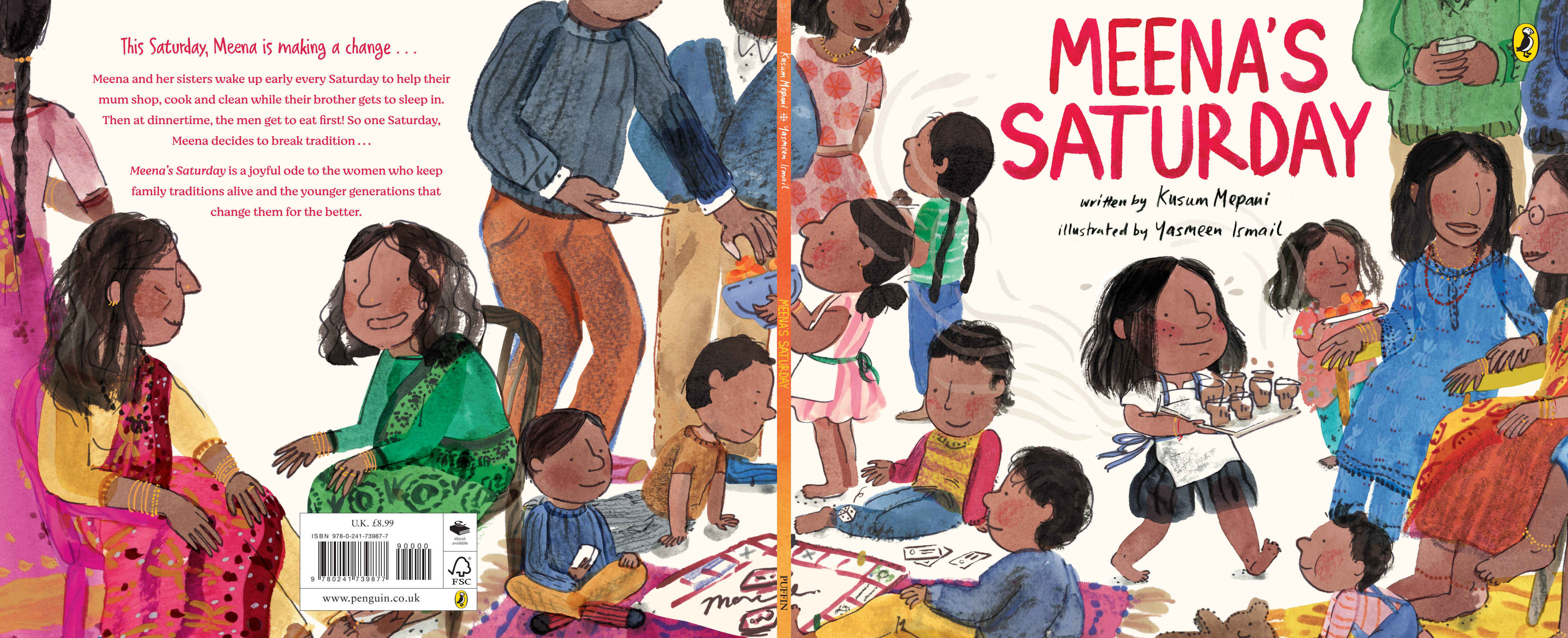

to do!

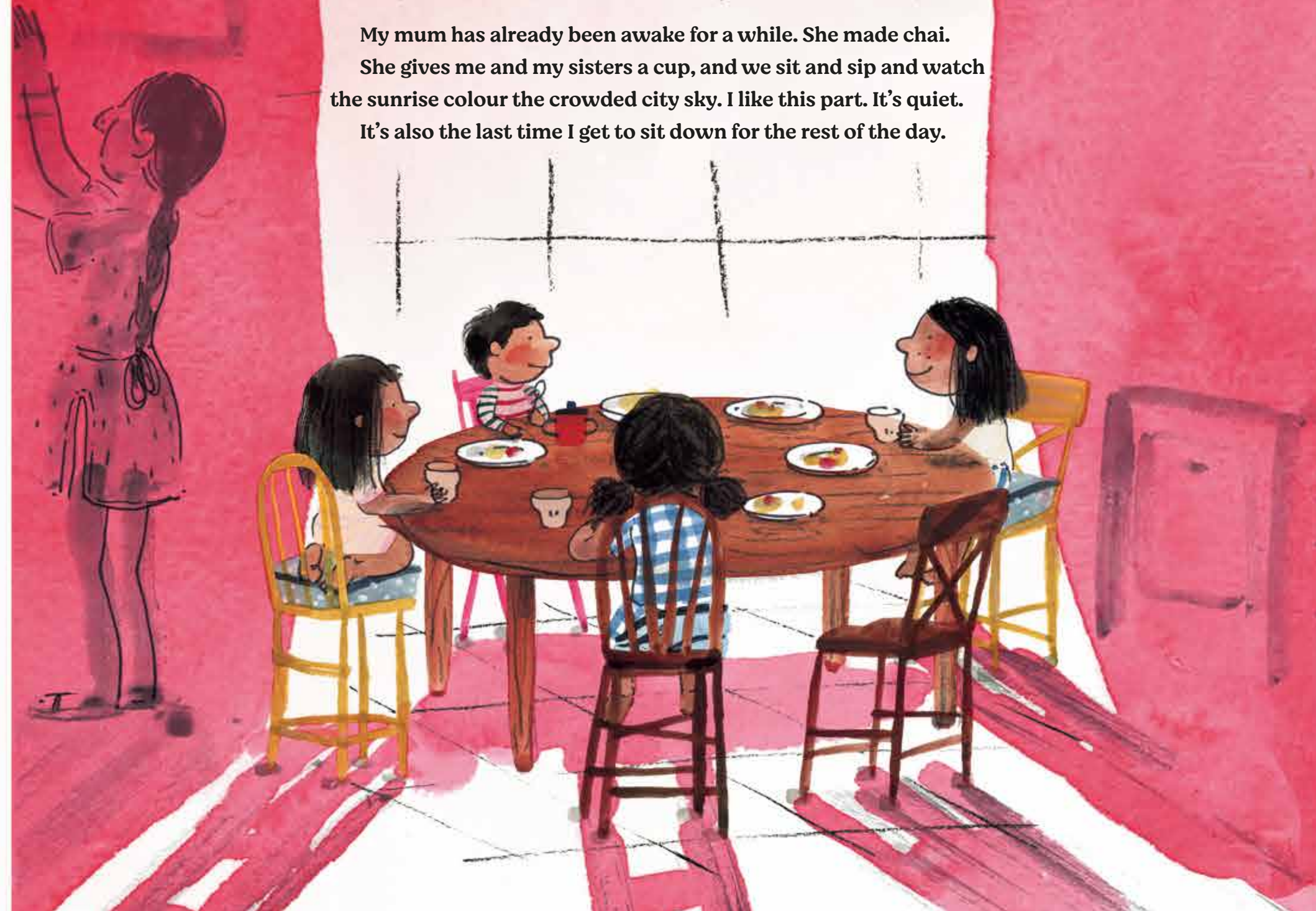
In my house,

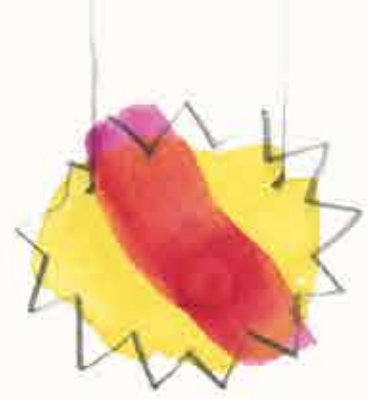
Scrub
