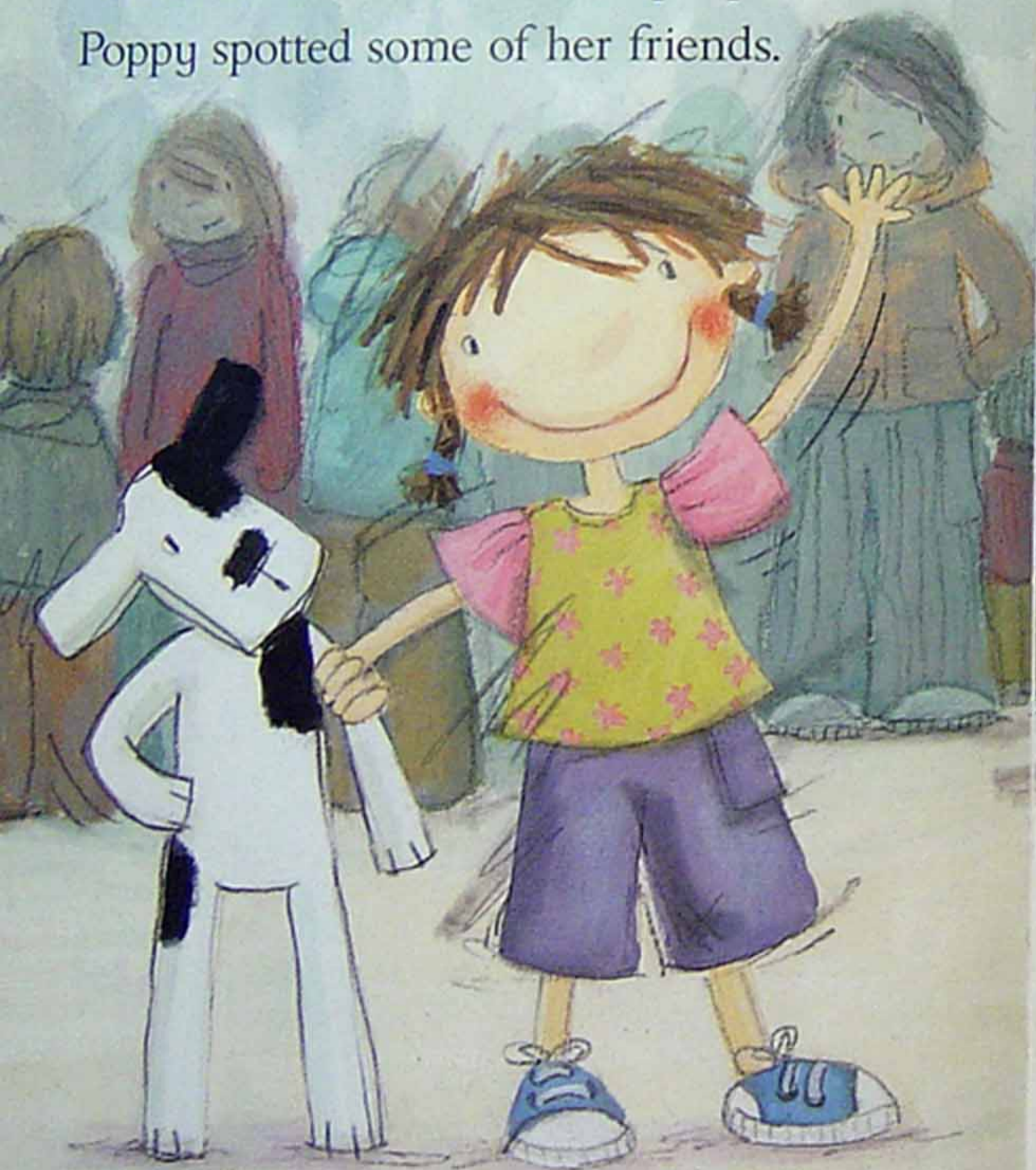
One day, Poppy and Max were out walking when they saw a poster outside the village hall.



“Brilliant!” cried Poppy. “I love dressing up.”

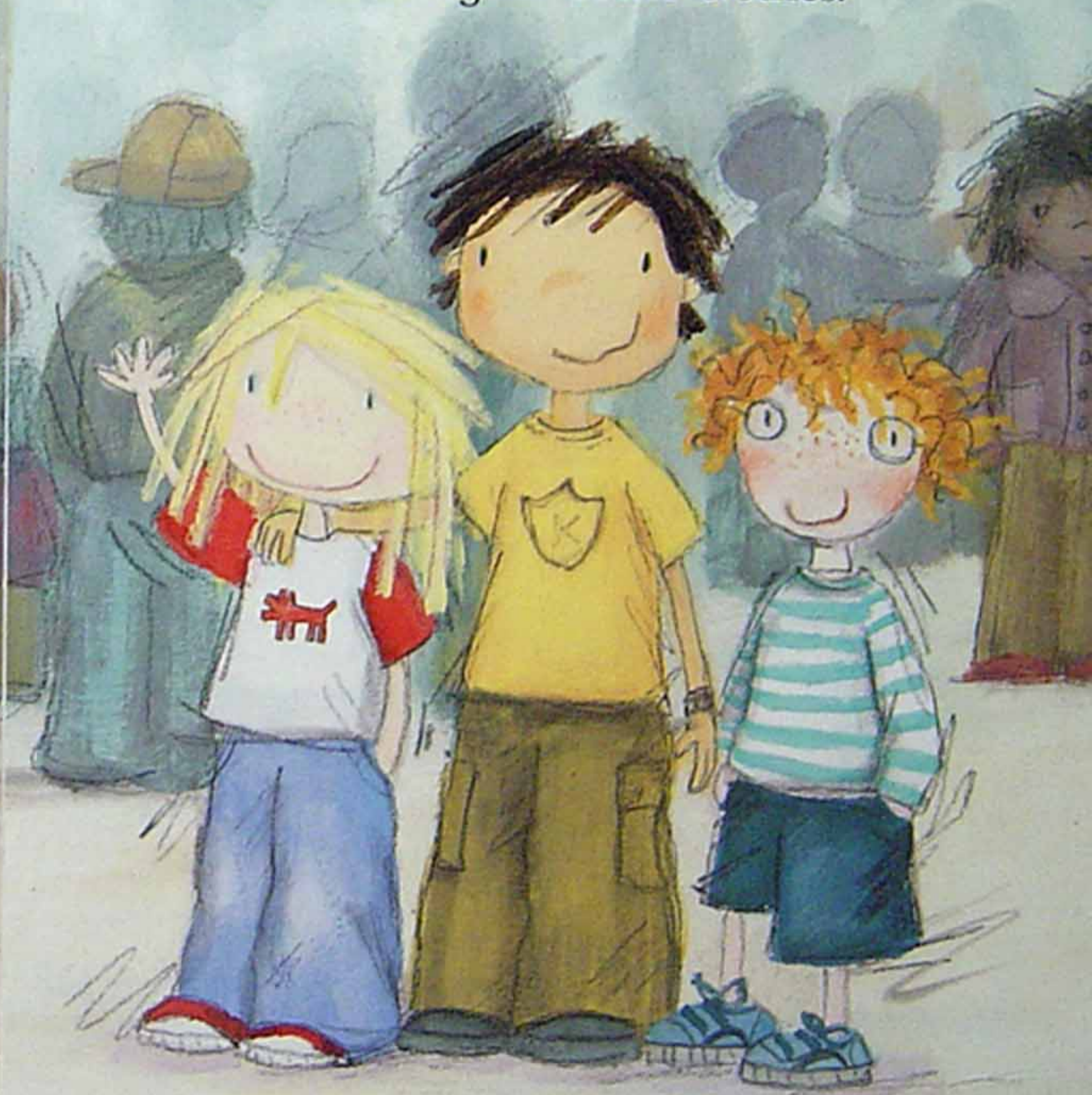
“I am not a dog who likes wearing clothes,” sniffed Max.

Poppy spotted some of her friends.

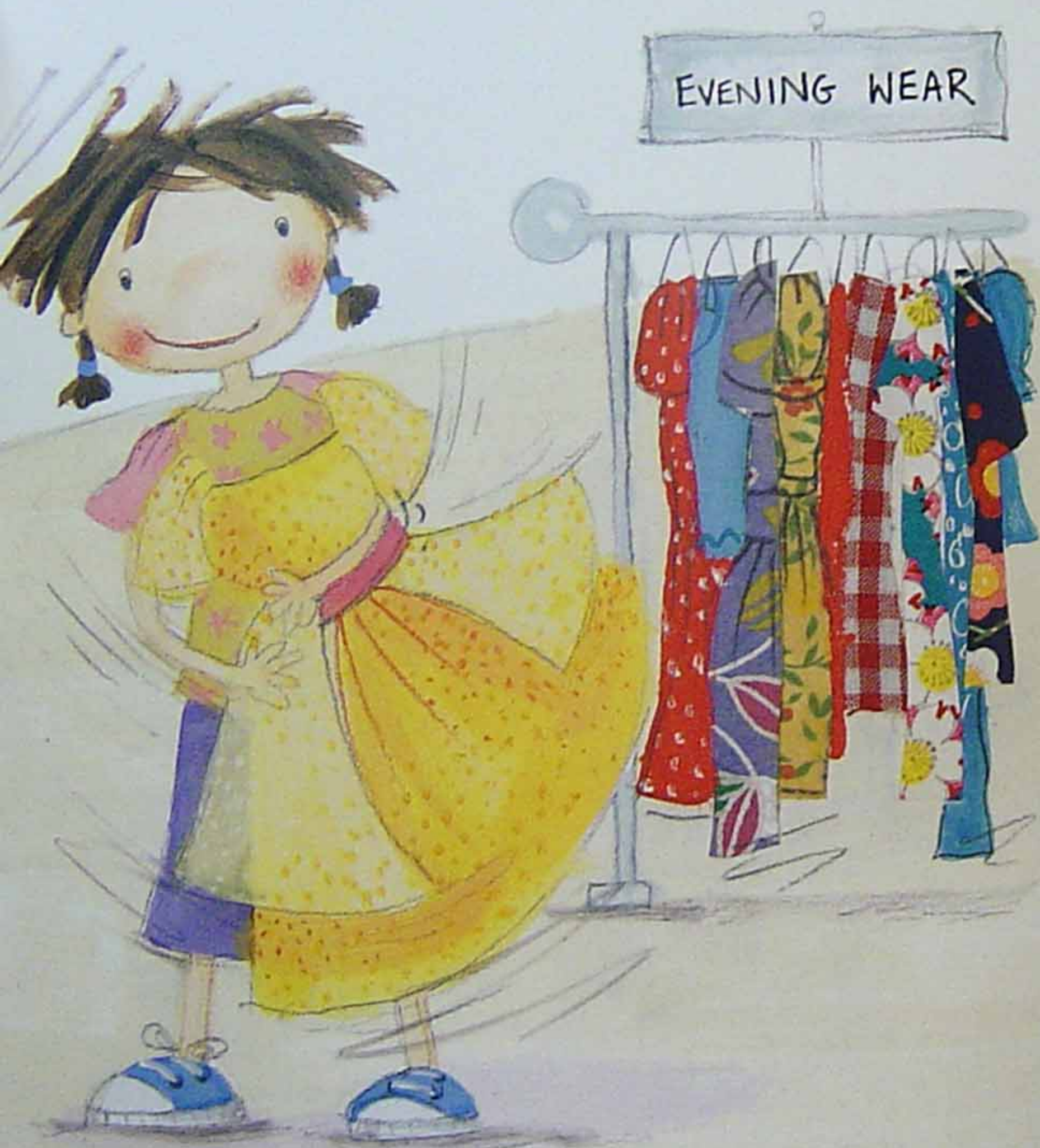


“Hello Chloe,” she called. “Hello Jack,

“Brilliant!” said Poppy. “I’m going to try on this ballgown.”



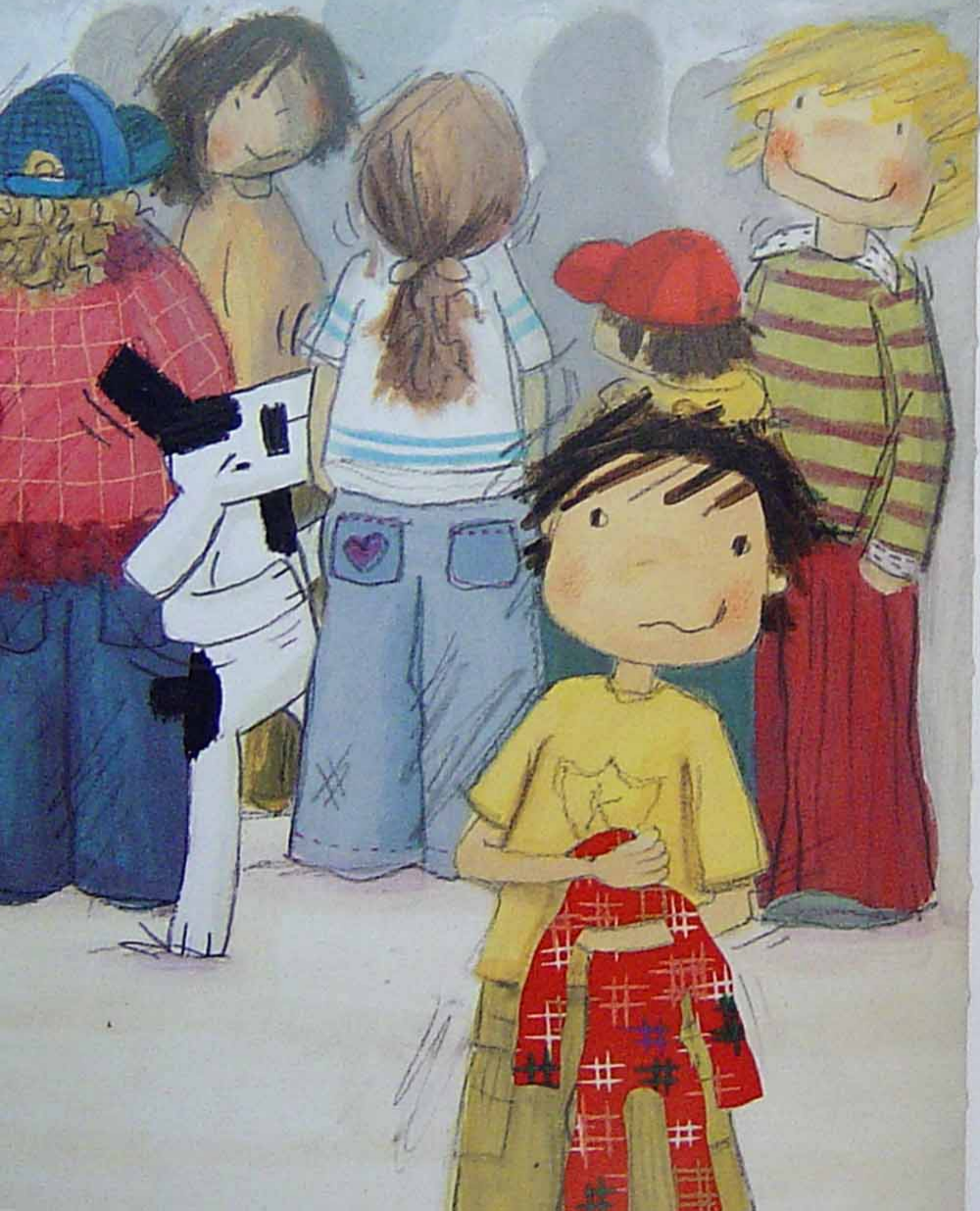
“Why don’t you put on this catsuit, Max?” laughed Jack.
