BACKGROUND

Lyra Belacqua is a feisty, inquisitive twelveyear-old girl. With dirty knees and tangled hair, she doesn't like being told what to do, and is happiest when she is running free with her friend Roger Parslow around the Oxford college that is her home.

However, Lyra has a destiny that she is unaware of. According to an ancient prophecy, she is the special child who will bring an end to a great war that began thousands of years ago.



Fortunately, Lyra is brave, resourceful, defiant and quick-thinking. She is also true to her word, and a loyal friend. When Lyra and Roger discuss the kidnapping of children in Oxford by the sinister Gobblers, she vows to rescue Roger if he is taken. Roger's sudden disappearance spurs Lyra into action, and she embarks on a quest to rescue him.
