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Equipment and Protection

Before one begins an expedition to observe the habits and habitats of fantastical creatures, there are several useful items one should collect.

A thomas with milk for appeasing and luring faeries. They like milk best lukewarm.



One twig each from an oak, an ash, and a thorn tree. Bind these together with red thread, and this will offer protection against faerie folk.



Shown here are:

- AMERICAN HONEYLOCUST (*Sorbus americana*)
- HONEY LOCUST (*Gleditsia triacanthos*)
- SCARLET OAK (*Quercus coccinea*)



A magnifying glass comes in handy, especially when studying smaller creatures like sprites and salamanders.



A bag of salt will dispell some magical illusions, and many faeries cannot abide it.



Bring a journal (and pencils) to record all of your findings. You never know what you may come across.

It should be noted that the color red is protective, but faeries do not like the color and will shy away from it in the same manner that bees fly from smoke, making the faeries more difficult to find. The color green will, by contrast, draw faeries, but they may not be pleased to find a human wearing their color.

When hunting for nocturnal creatures such as banshees and will-o'-the-wisps, a flashlight is quite helpful.



A backpack or satchel is useful for carrying everything. Make sure it has a iron or steel clasp to keep faeries from stealing your inventory!
