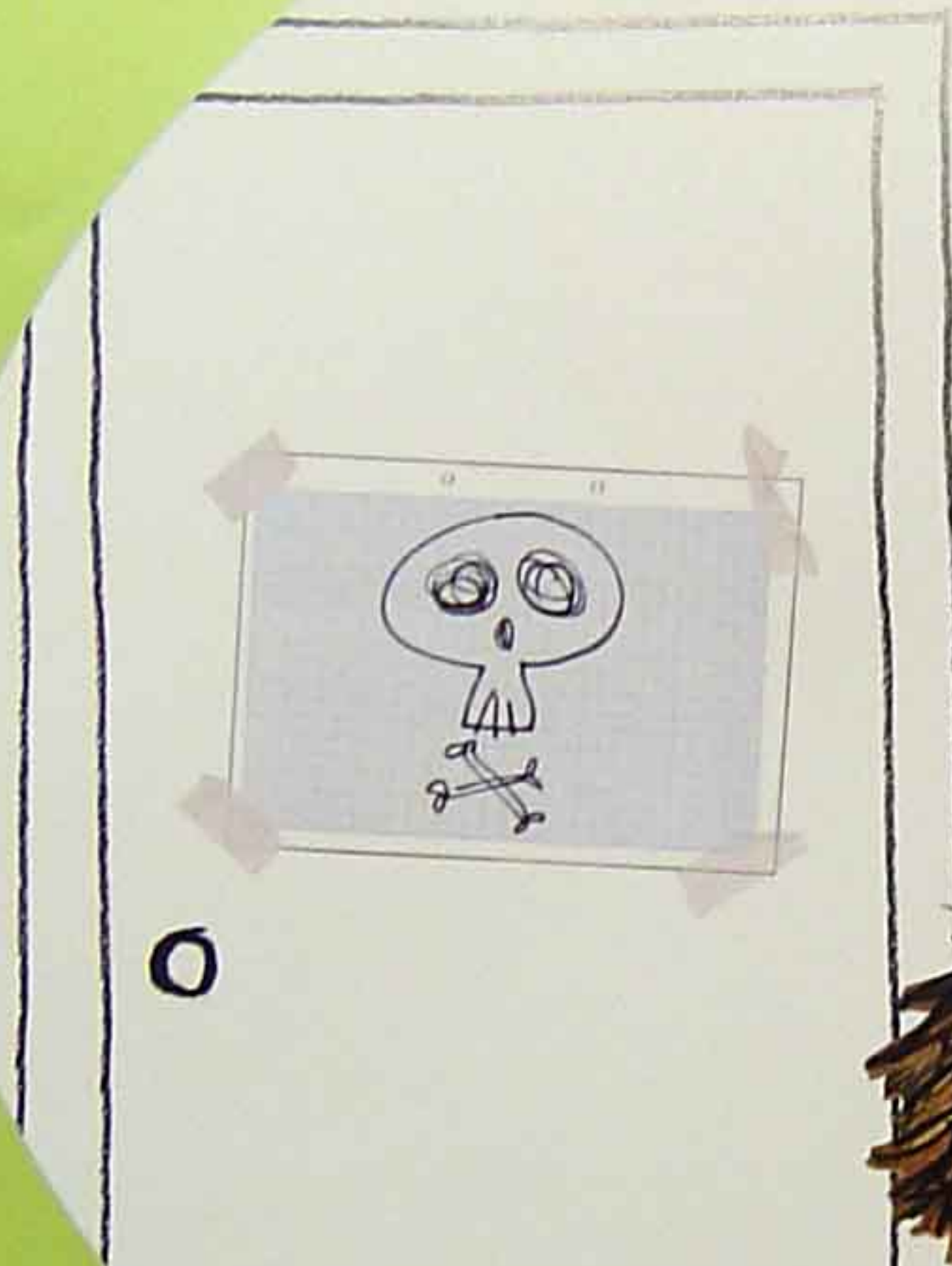


I have this little sister Lola.

we went to Marv's house?"

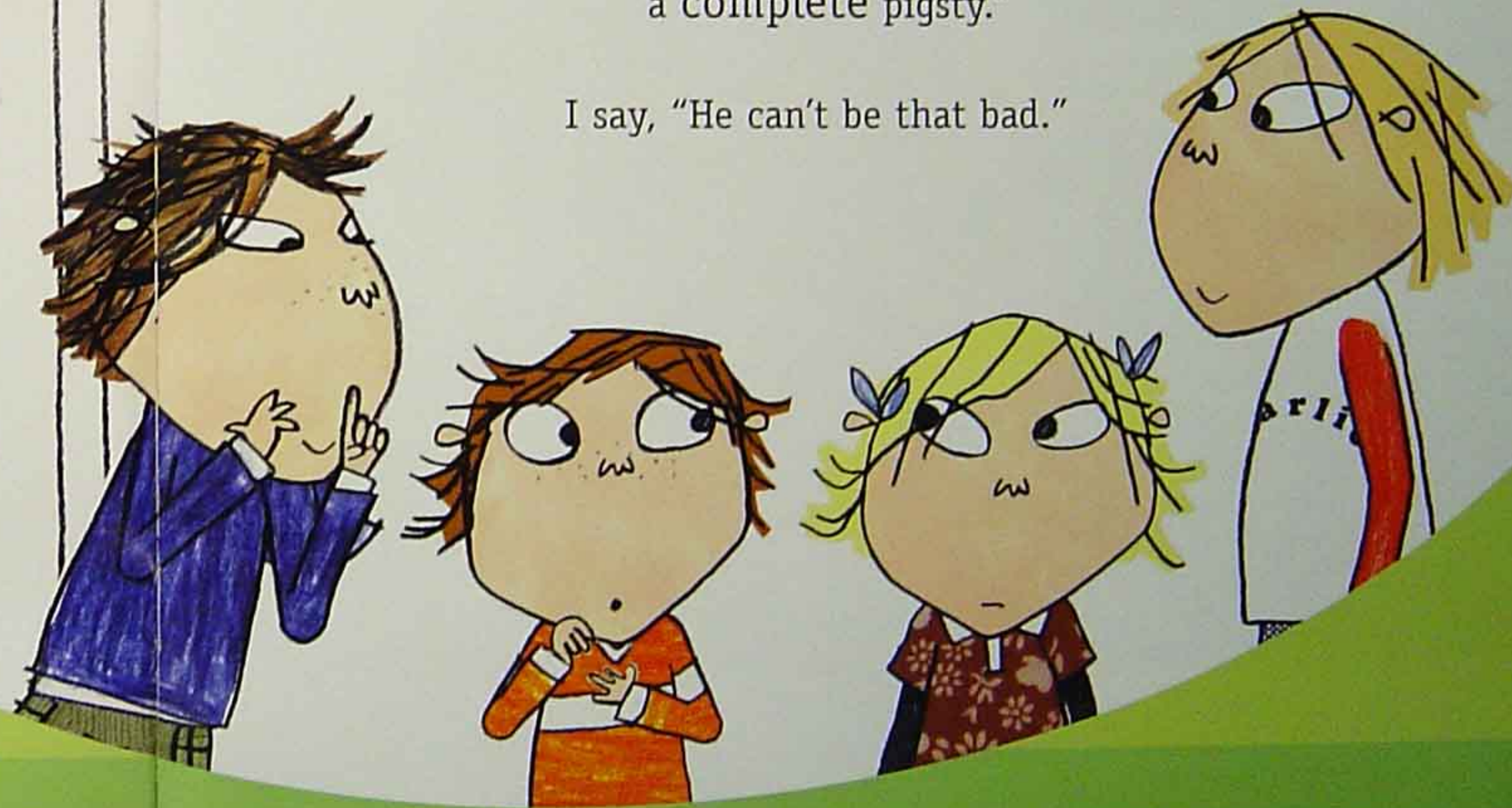
And Lola says,
