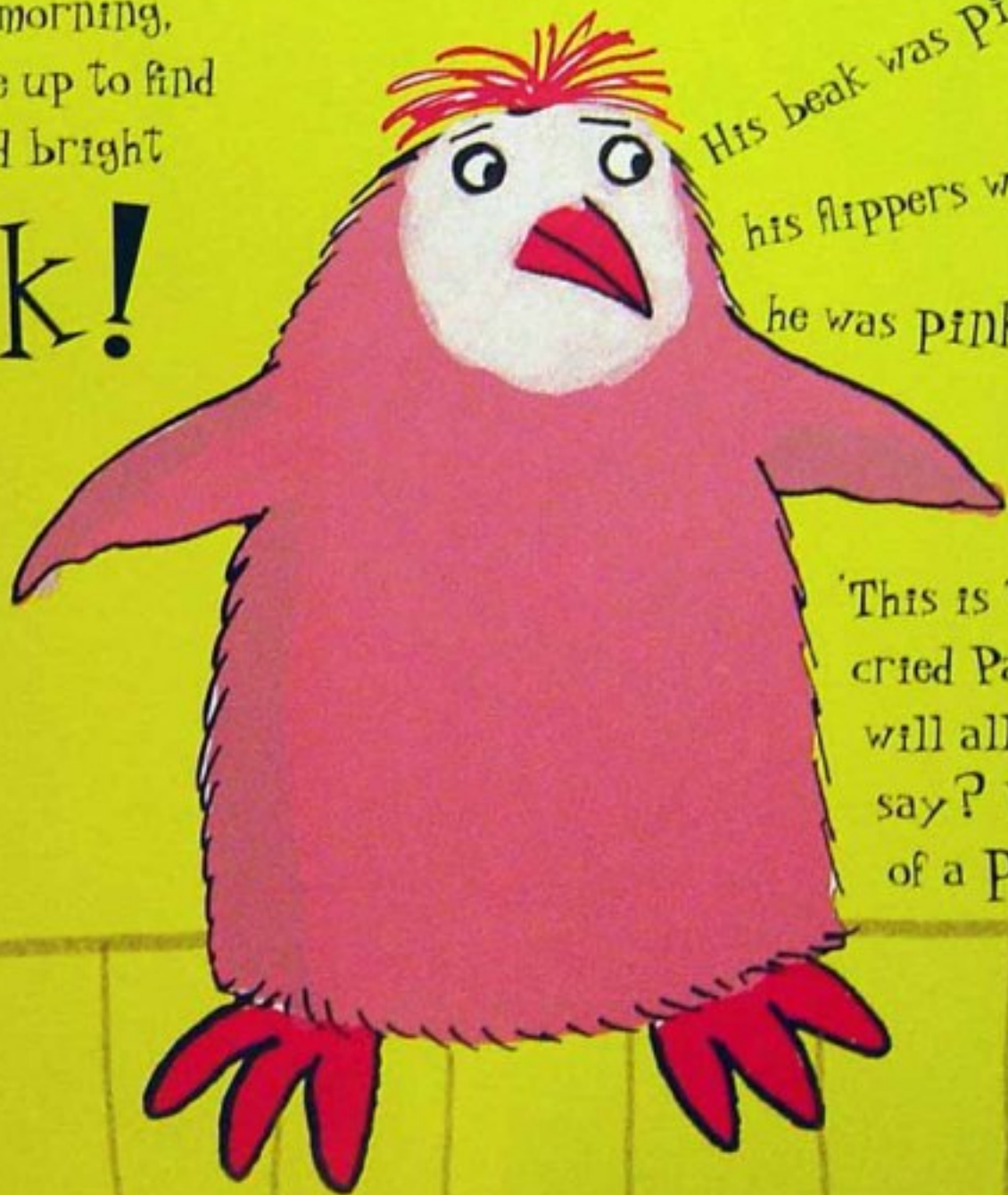

his flippers were pink —

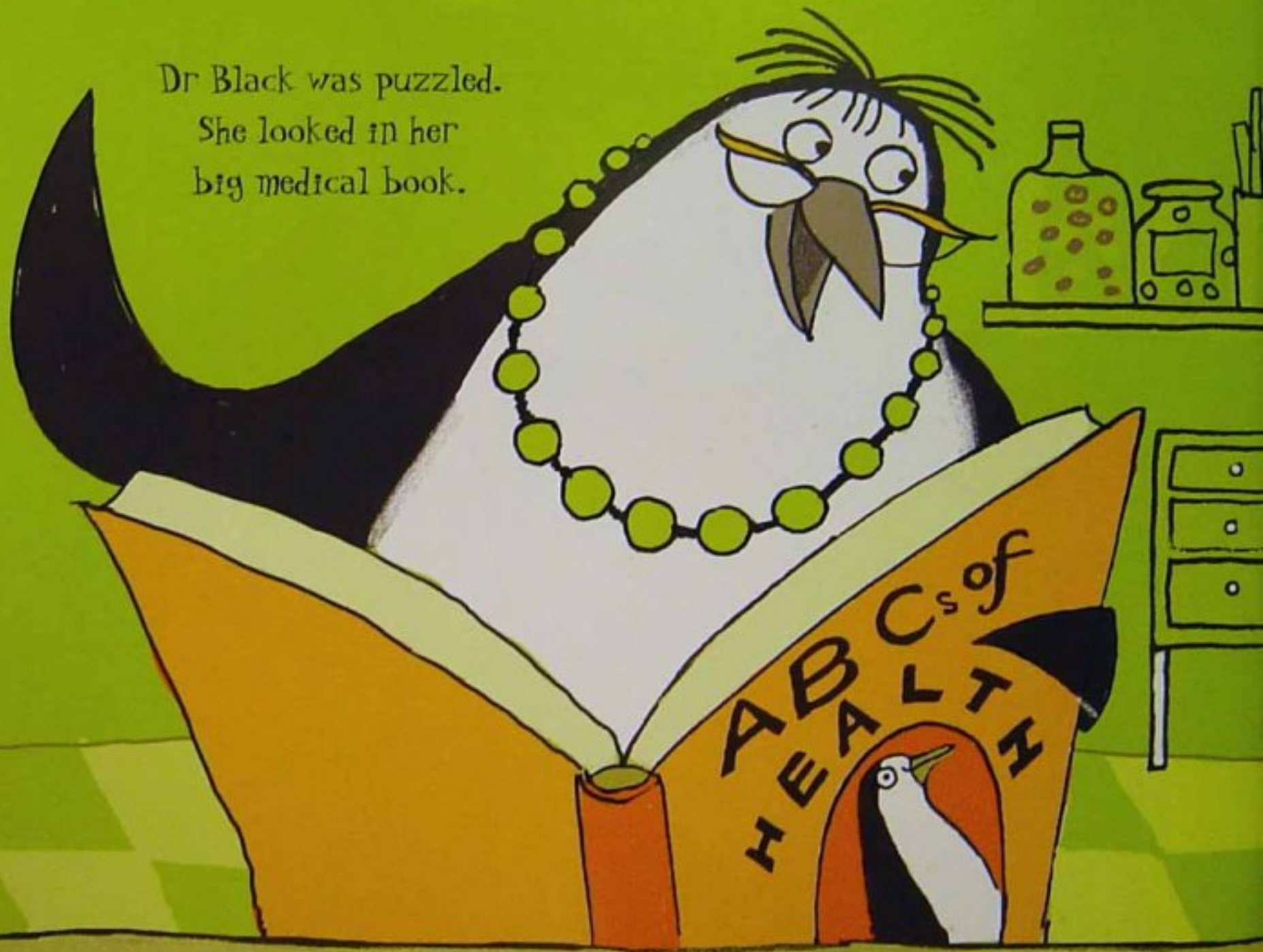
he was pink from head to foot.
