VICTOR HUGO

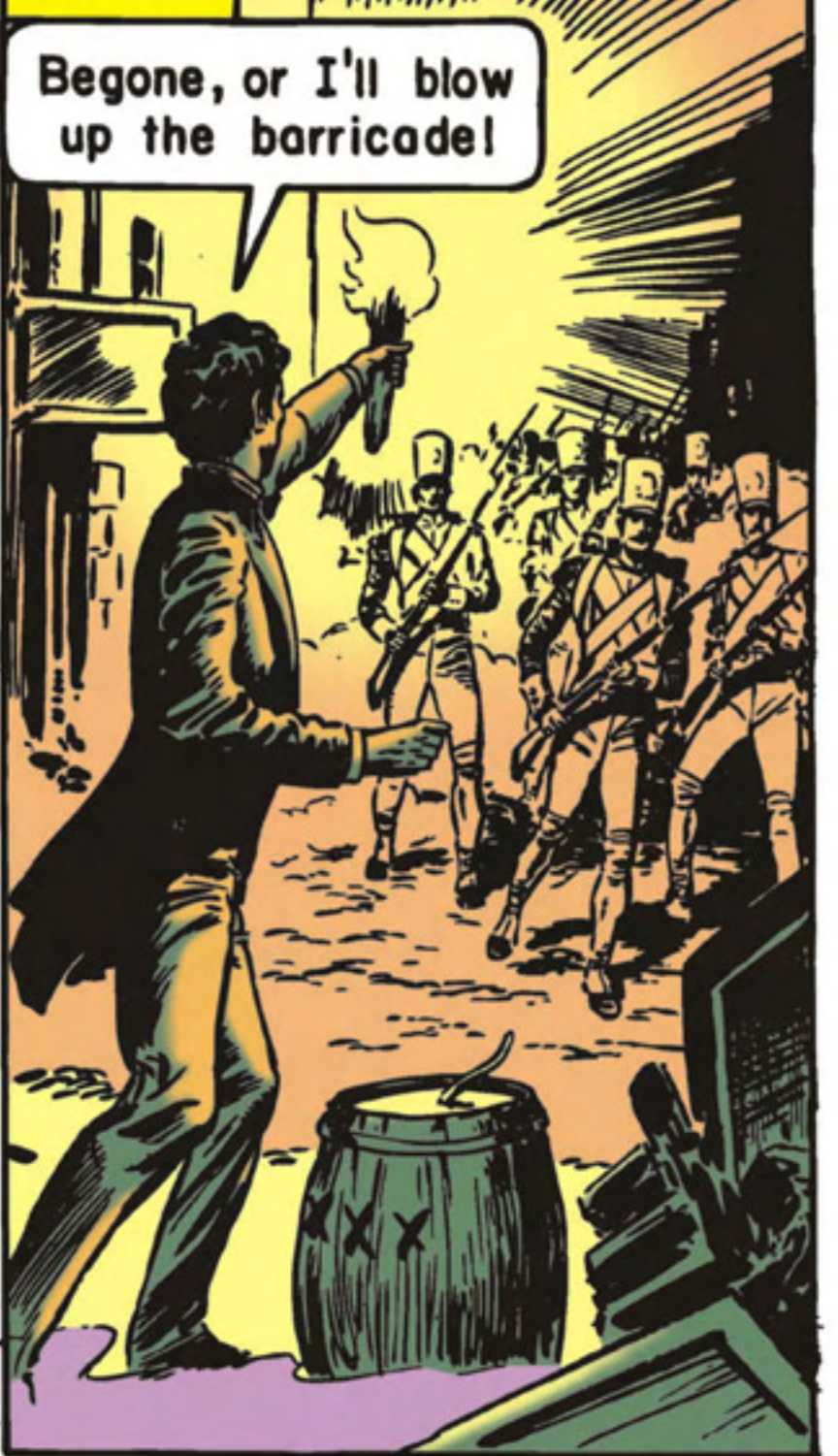


The unfortunate and the infamous are associated in the words, *Les Miserables*. There were many such people in France in 1815. One of them was Jean Valjean.
