Suddenly the phone rang.

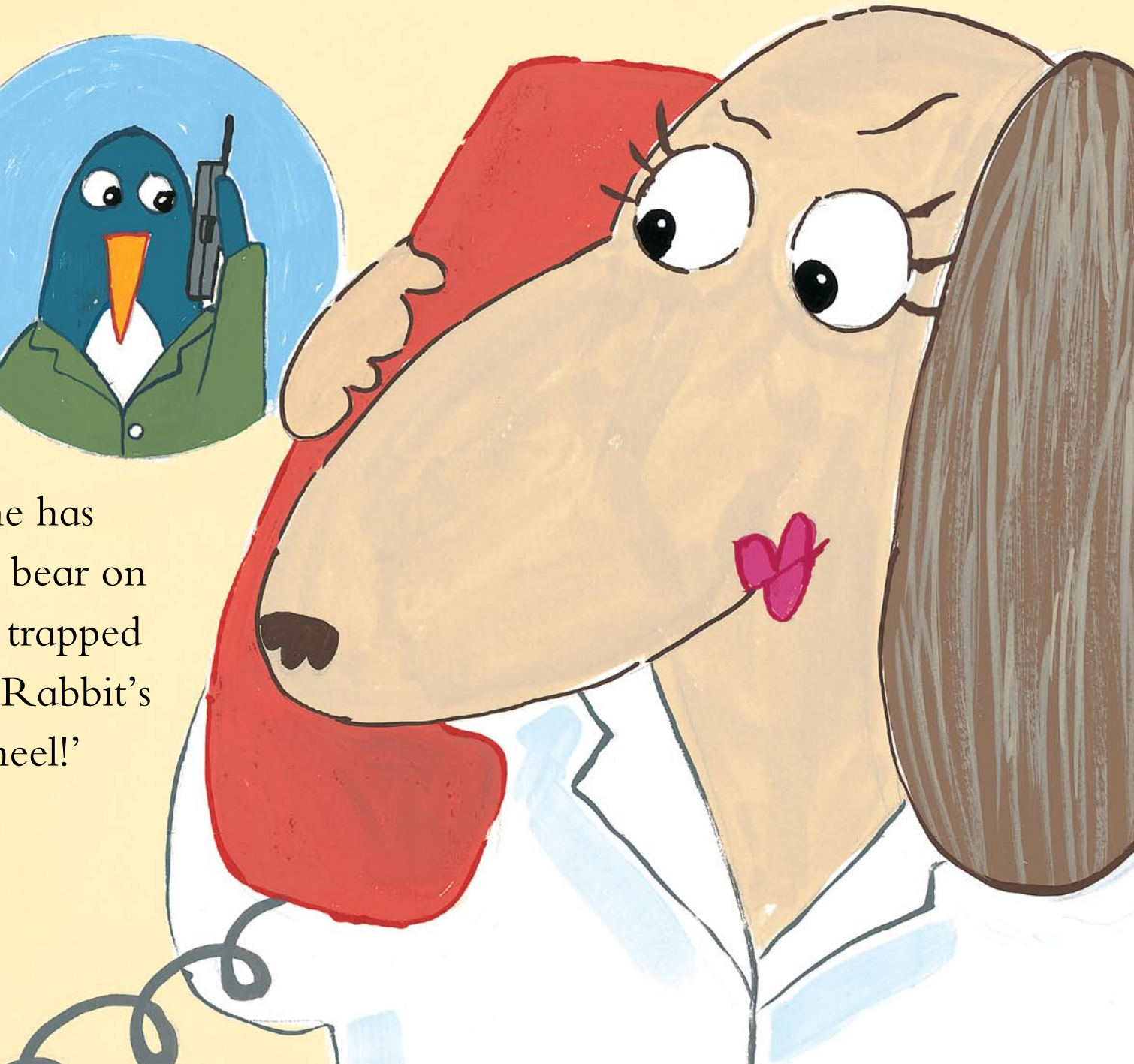


Doctor Glenda picked it up.
