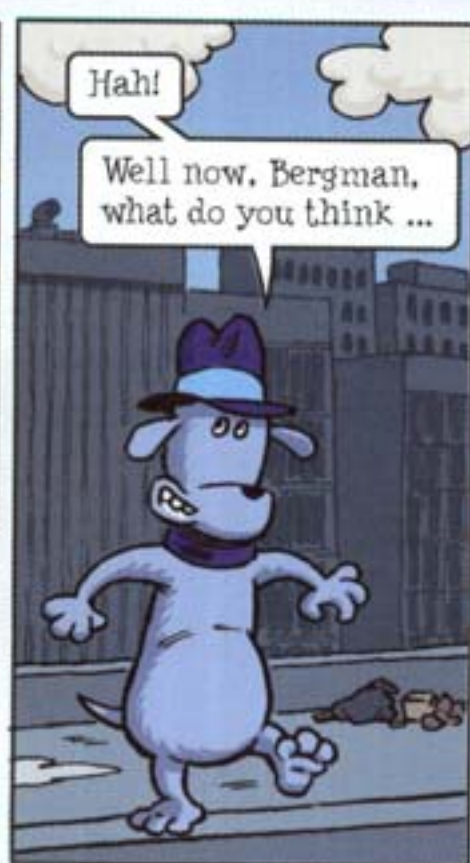
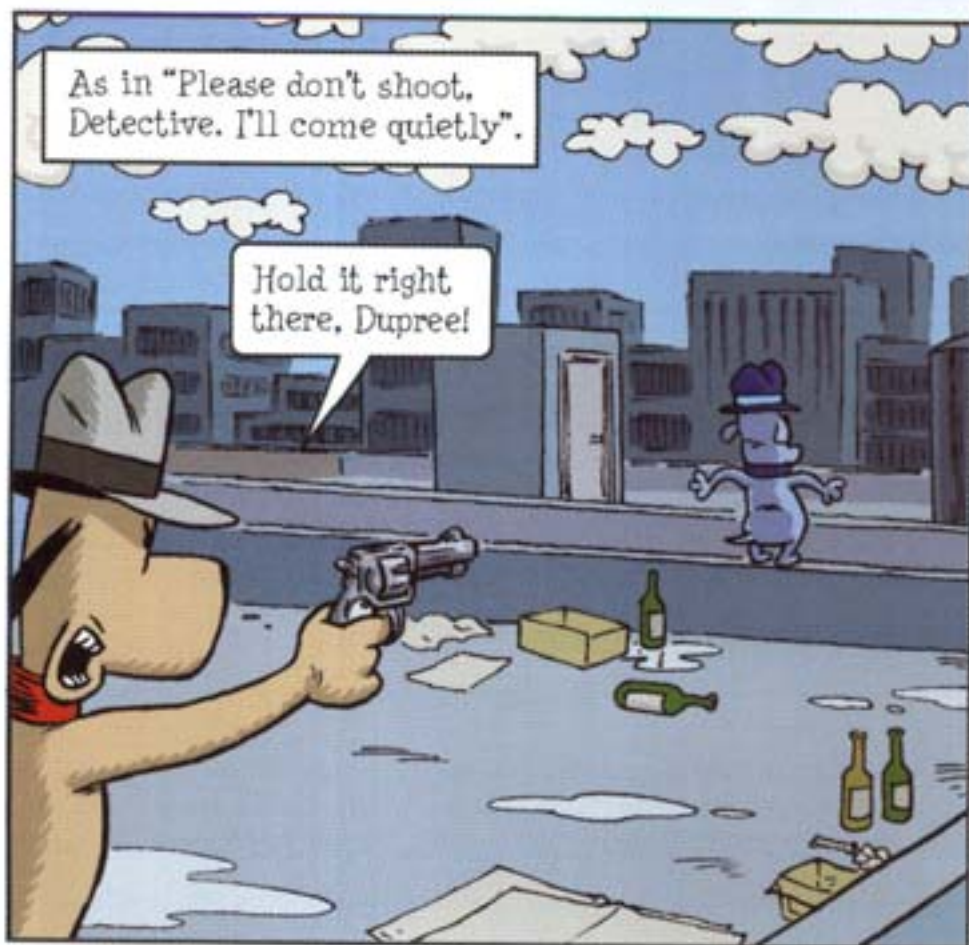

Um, difficult to say, Sir. You'd better see for yourself.

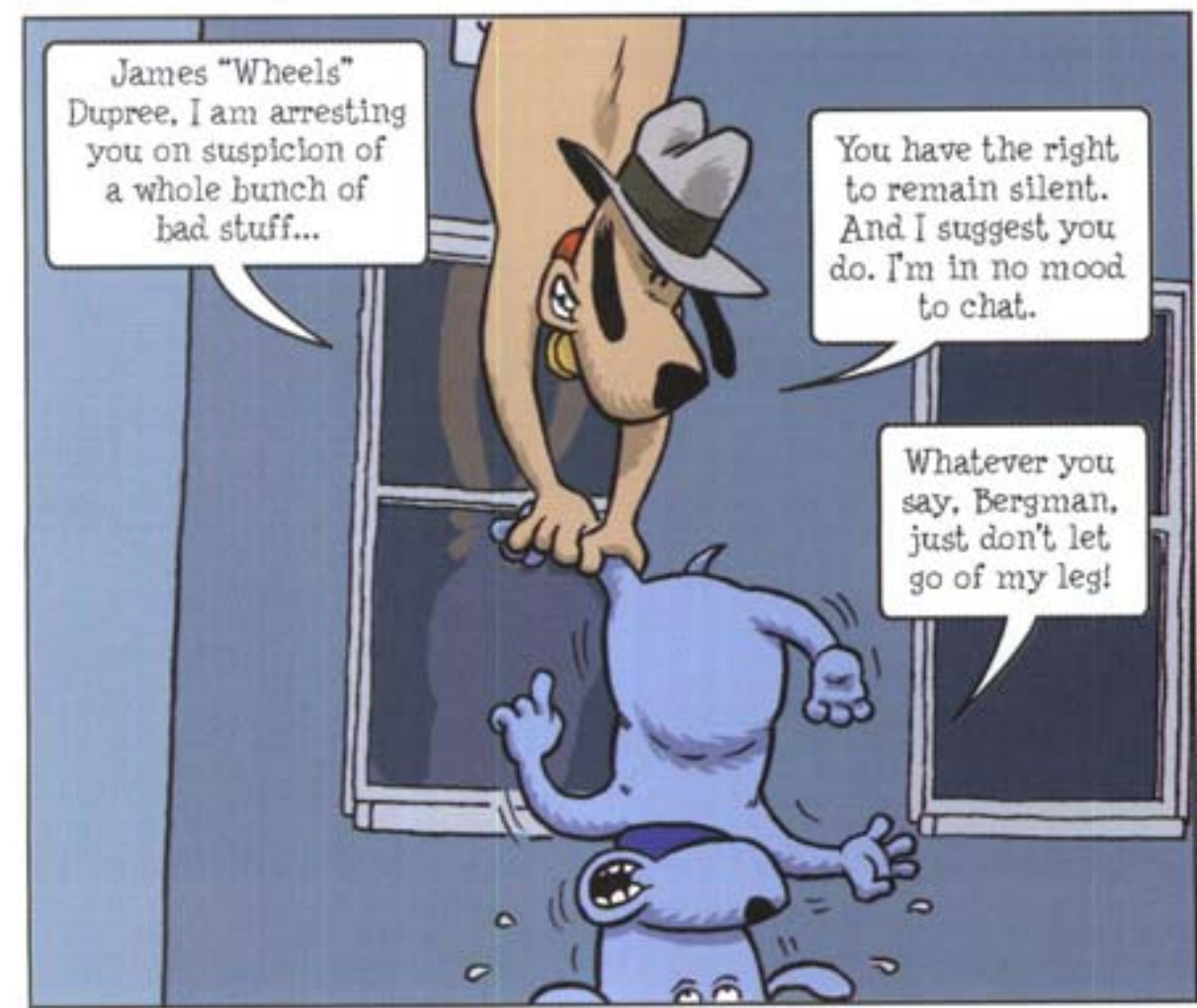


Oh deary me!
