◆ THE GREATEST VIKING

Only fools dared defy Thor, the sky god who thundered across the heavens, leaving lightning in his wake and bashing foes with his enchanted hammer, Mjöllnir. Beloved among the Norse people, this favourite son of Odin was the ultimate berserker, but had many human-like shortcomings and often made foolish decisions. During one of his misadventures, Thor pitted himself in a race against Thought and lost. Soon after, he challenged Old Age to a wrestling match, a contest nobody could ever win. Hammer-shaped amulets worn by young brides honoured Thor's bravery and were thought to provide protection from evil.
