

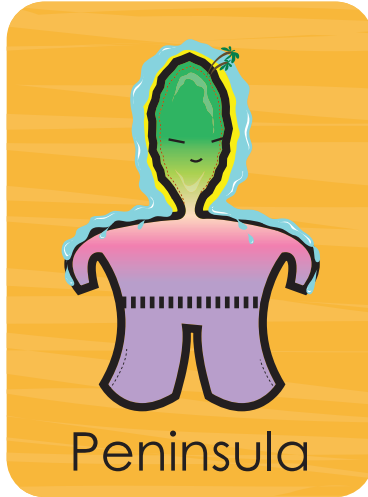


Peninsula

- Biggest: Greenland (2,175,600 km²)
- Eighth biggest: G. Britain (229,870 km²)
- Biggest archipelago: 17,000 Islands
