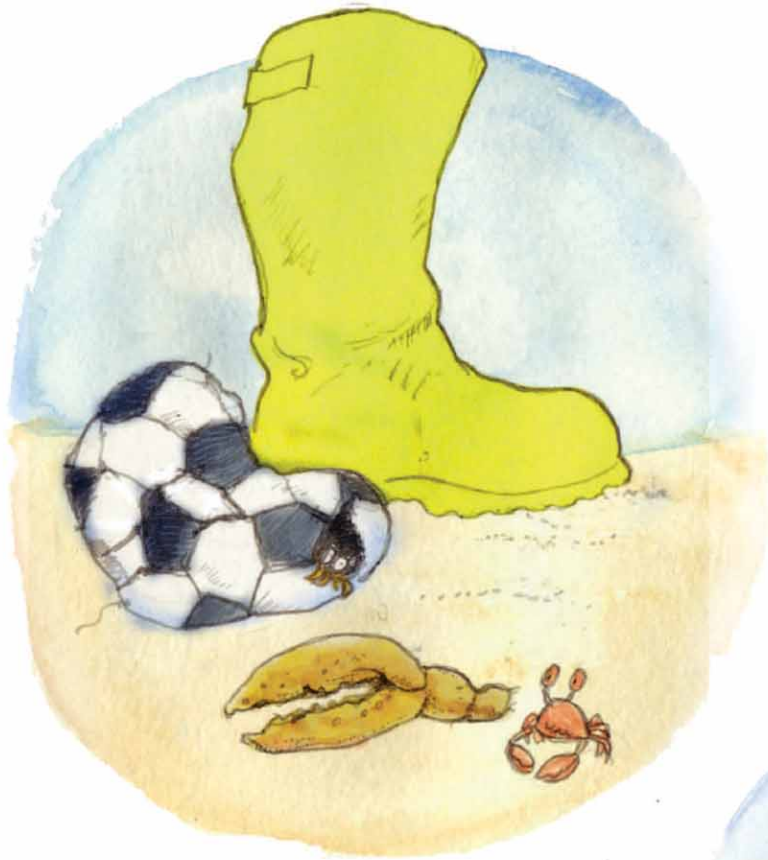

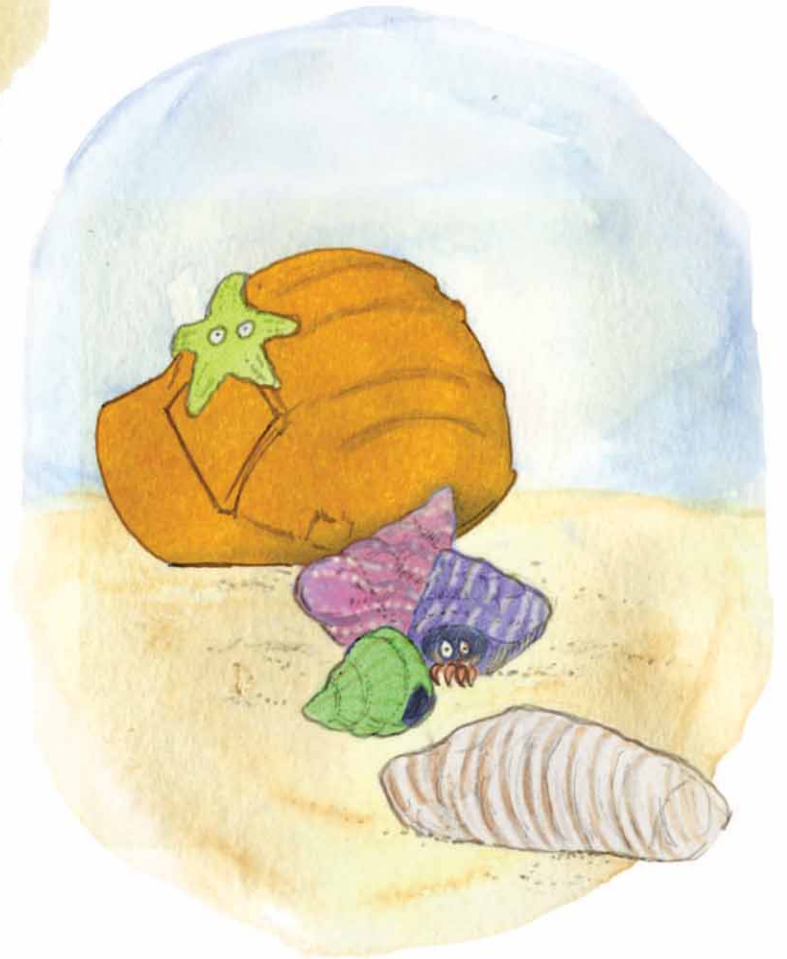
On the day of the big bottom hunt, Sandy and Ella went beach-combing. They took a bucket, a net and a magnifying glass.

The week before, they found an orange hard hat, three spiral shells and a stripy stone.






On the day of the big bottom hunt, Sandy saw something glitter by the jaggy rocks.
