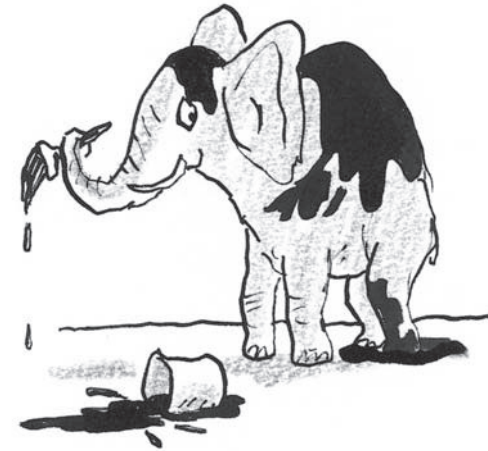
MY TOP PURPLE JOKES

Lon.*

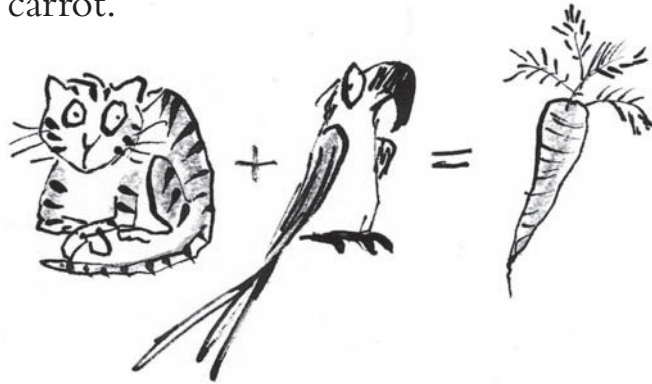

A stinkbomb.

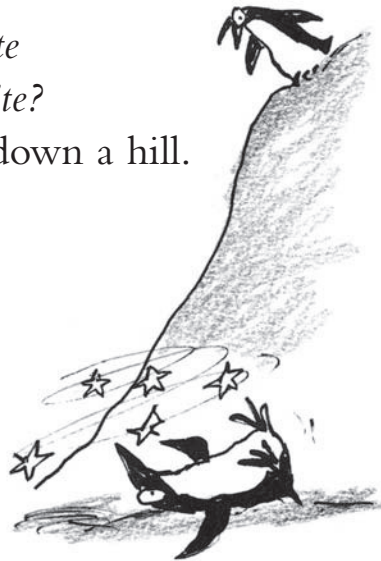

pushed him.*

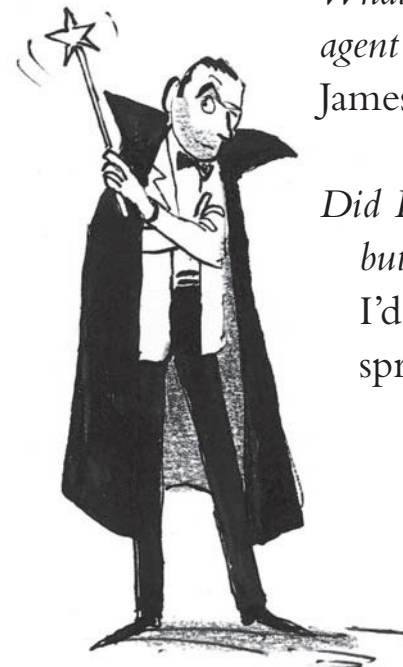


*Why did the mushroom enjoy the party
