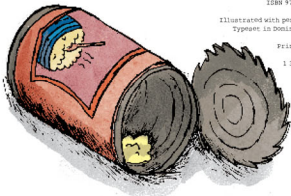

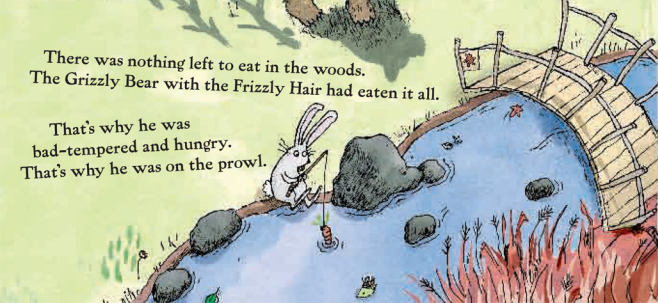

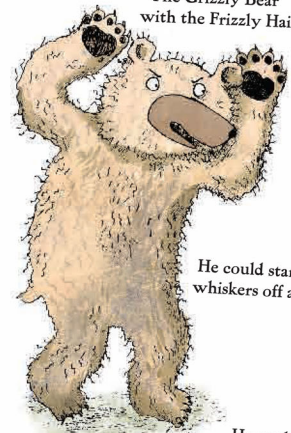


There was nothing left to eat in the woods.
