said Titus.



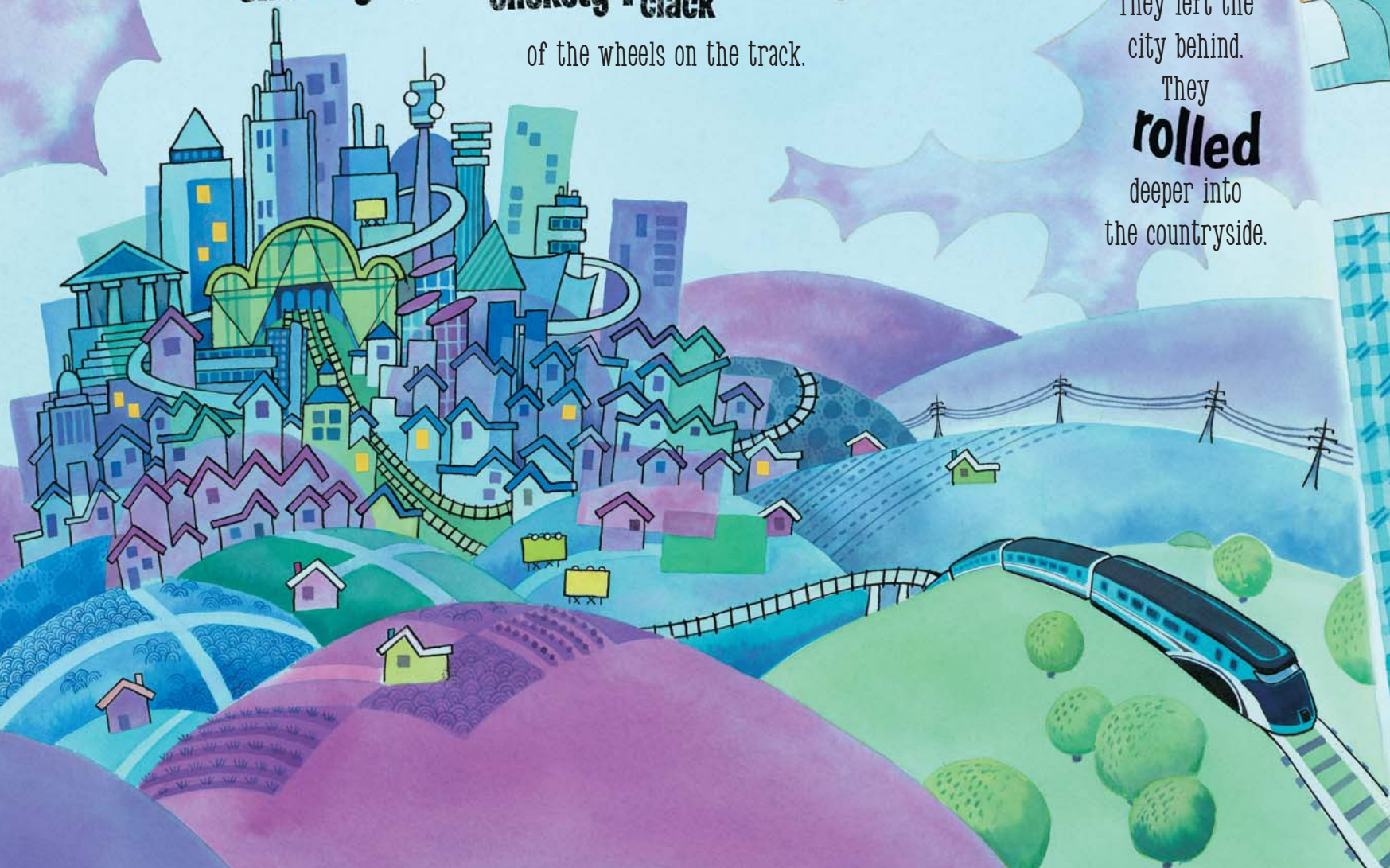
Soon he was listening to the
