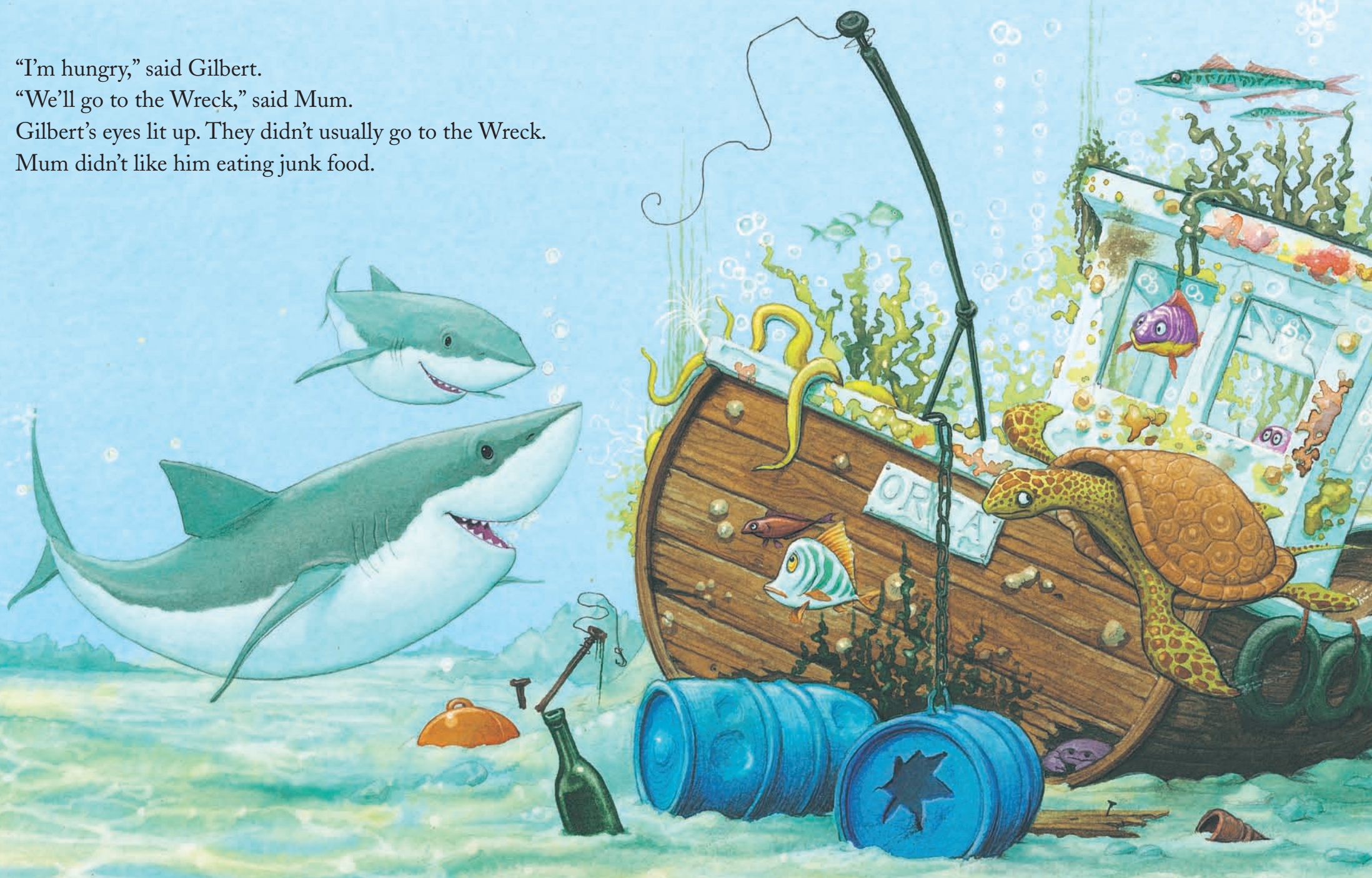


“I’m hungry,” said Gilbert.
