to look at his little daughter.



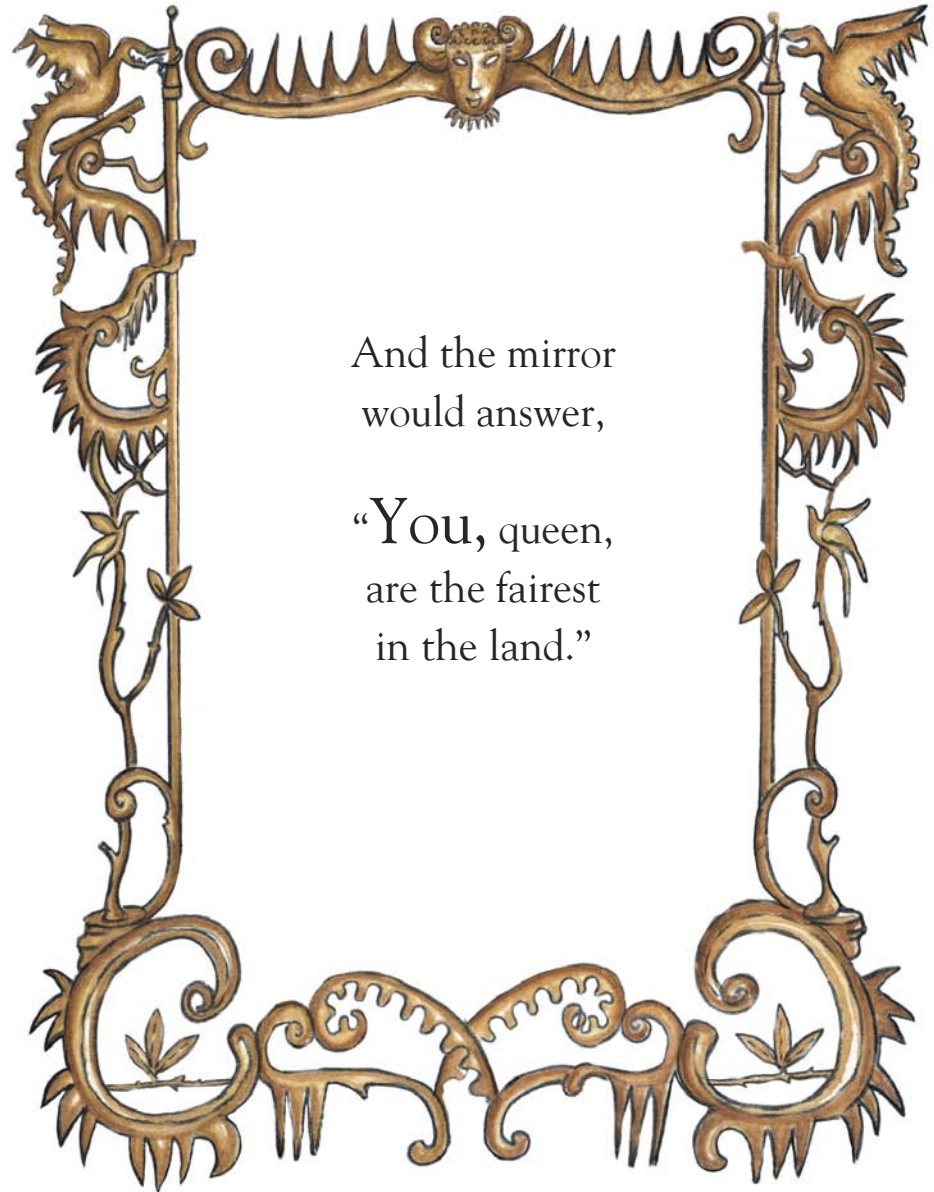
Snow White was taken away to
