“And chew with your mouth shut!” snapped Dad.



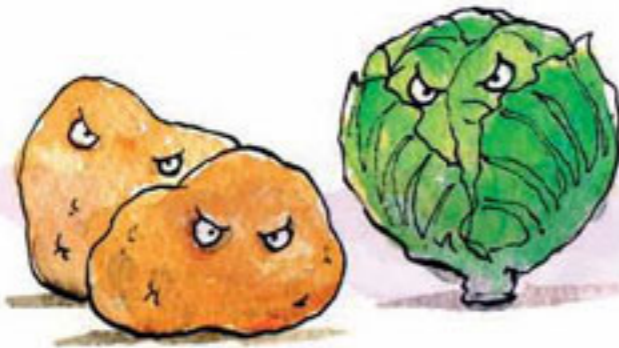
