and peel her swimming costume off again...

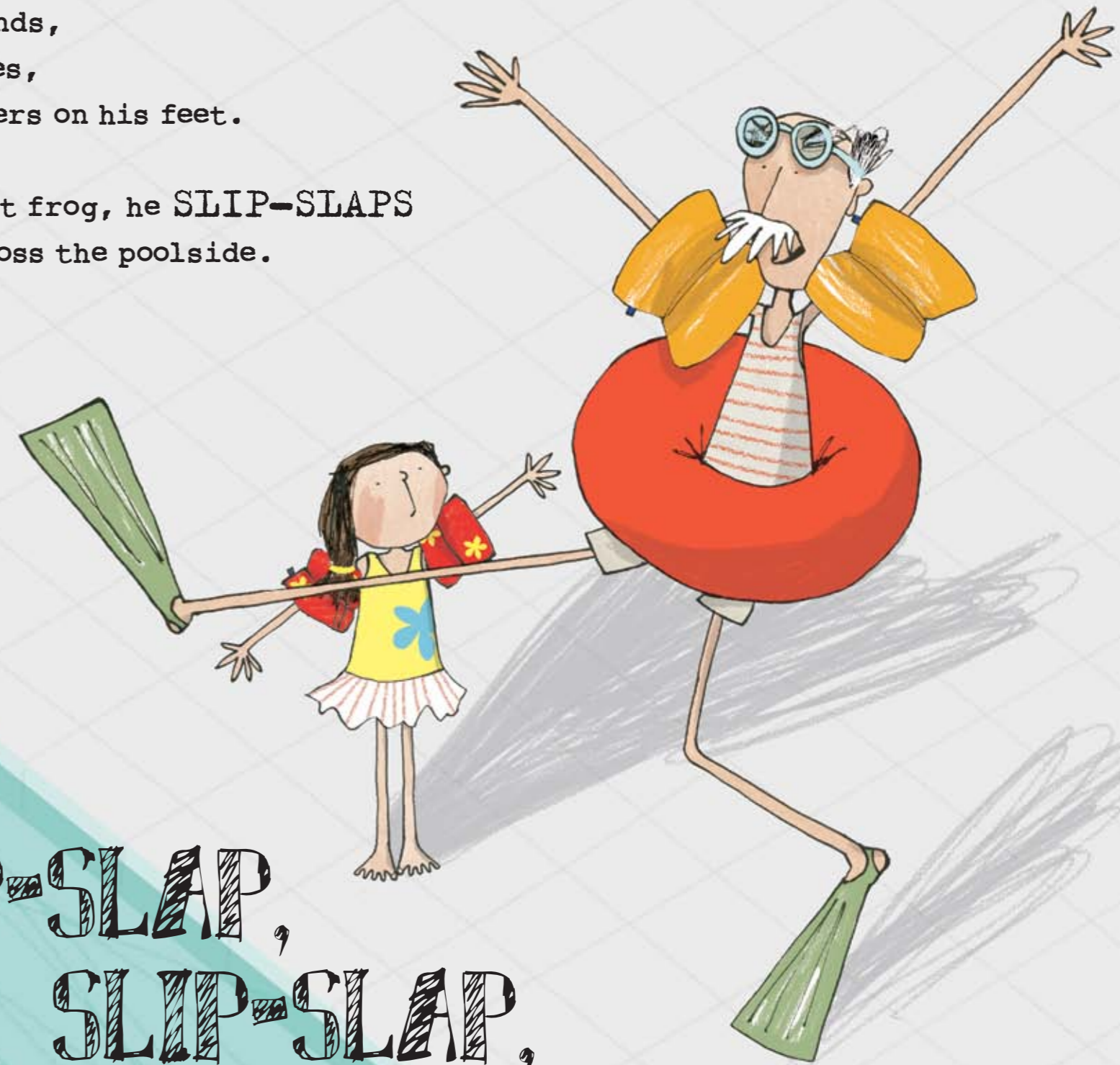


Grandpa takes her hand and whispers,
