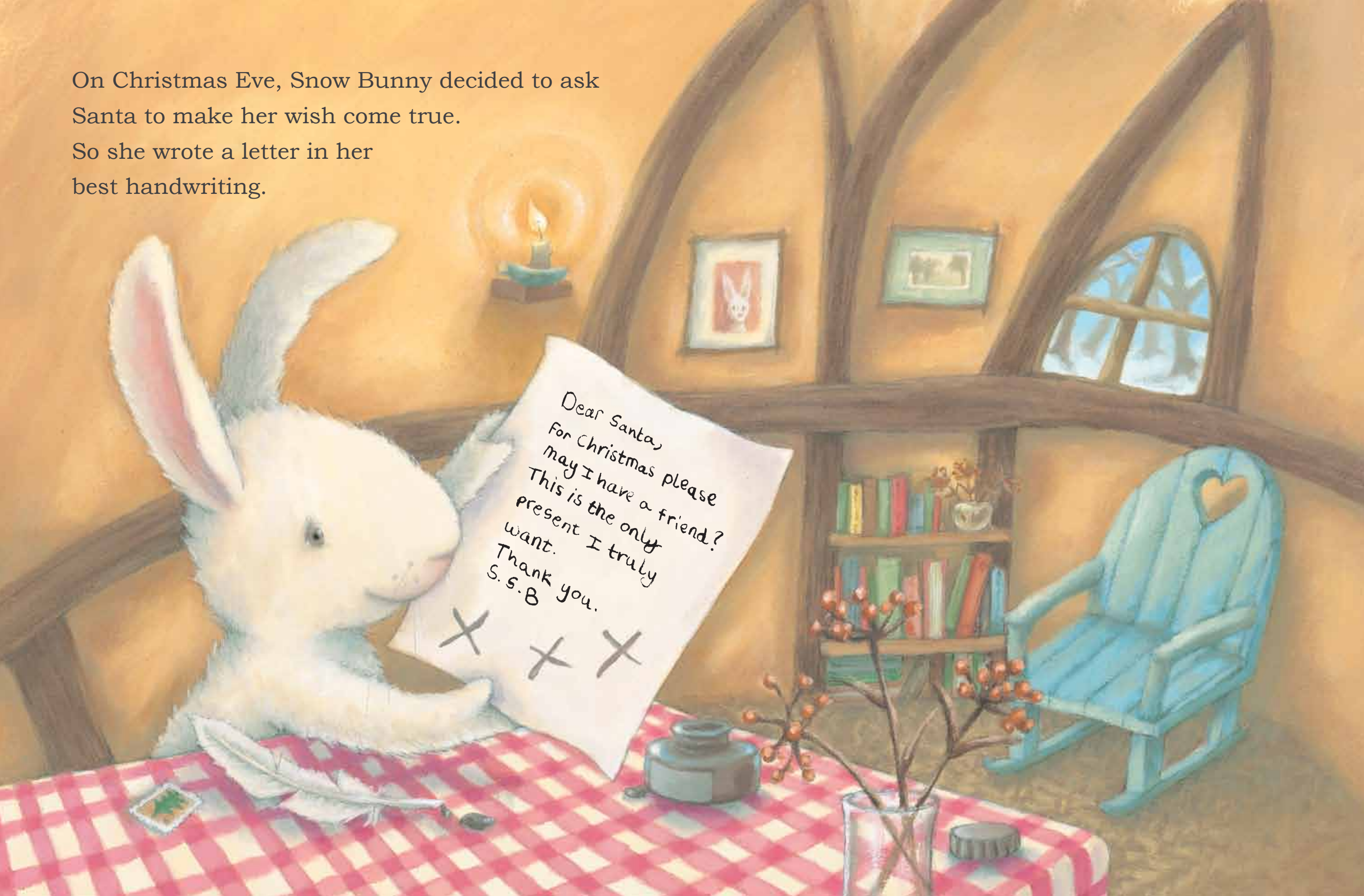




Snow Bunny lived all by herself
