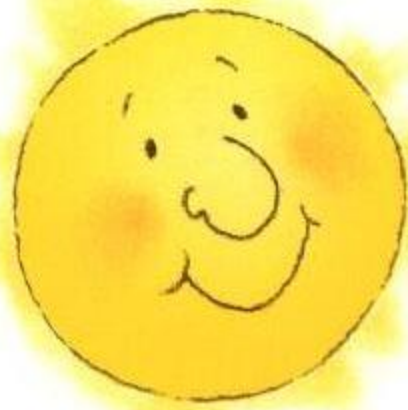

God made the earth spin, which made the day and night, and he made the moon go round the earth, which made the months, and he made the earth go round the sun, which made the years.

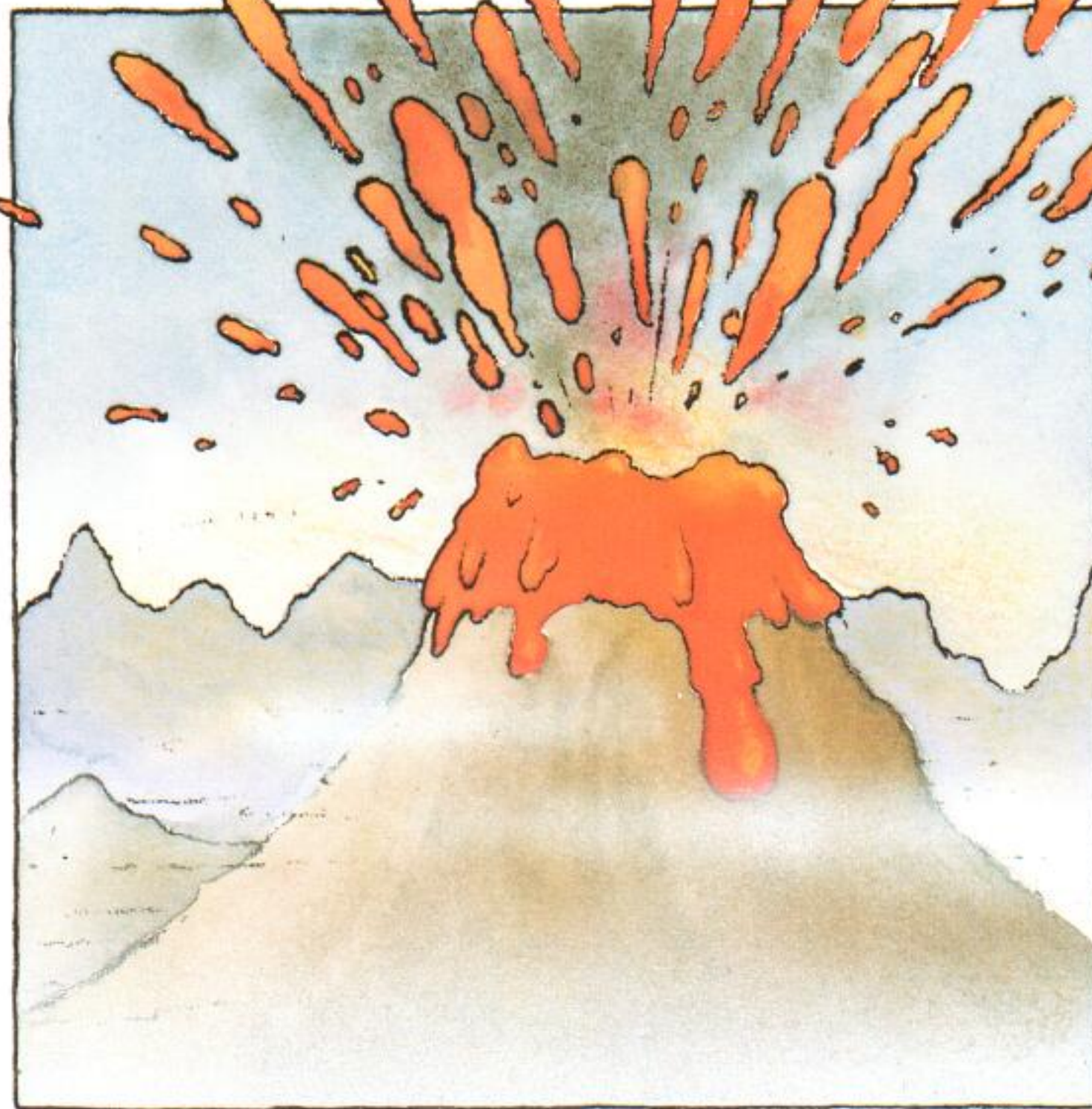
Then, with his finger, he gently nudged the North Pole a little to one side, which made the summer turn to winter and back again.

It was all very complicated, like making a giant clock.

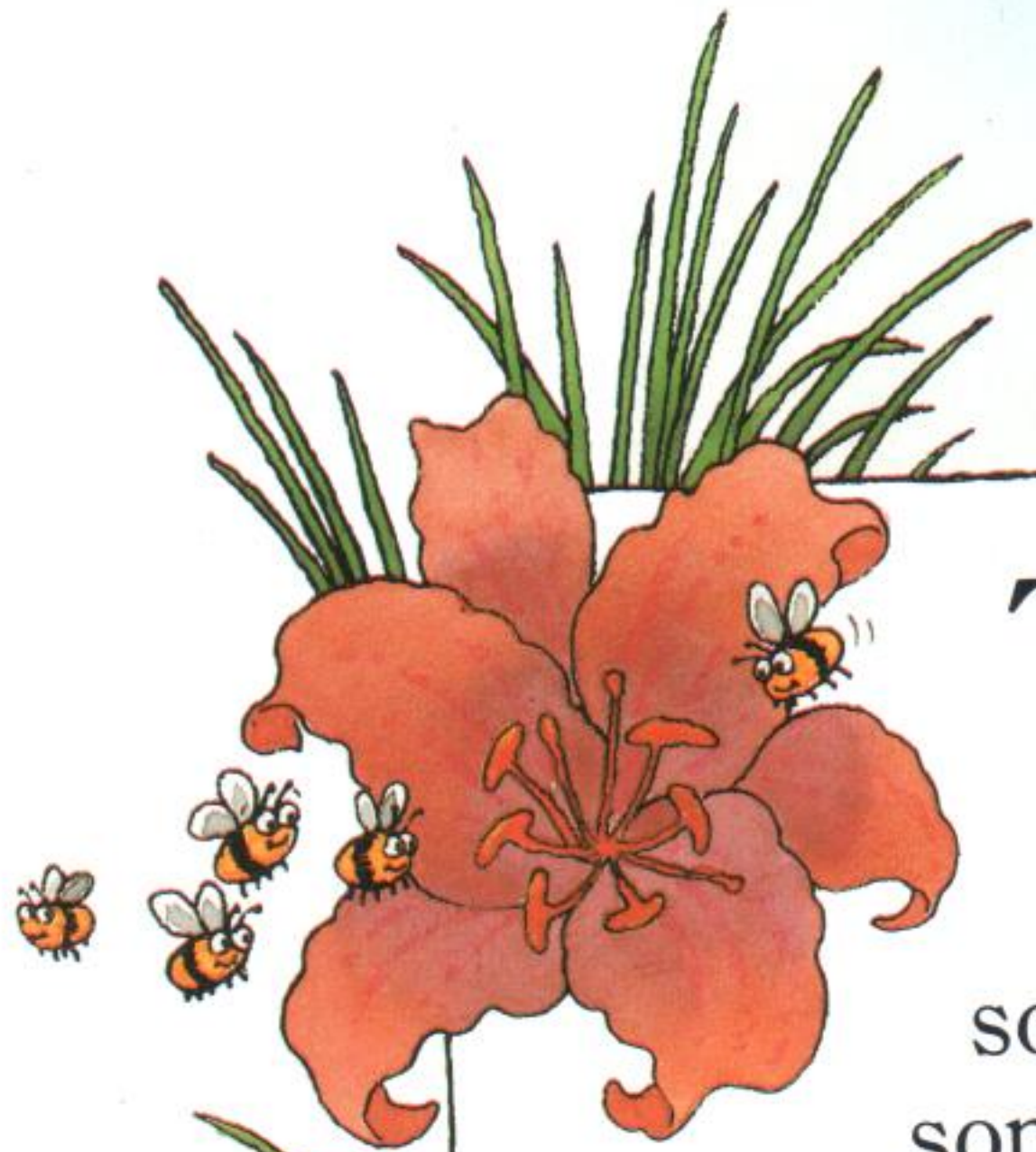
But it all worked perfectly!

and deserts and huge exploding volcanoes!

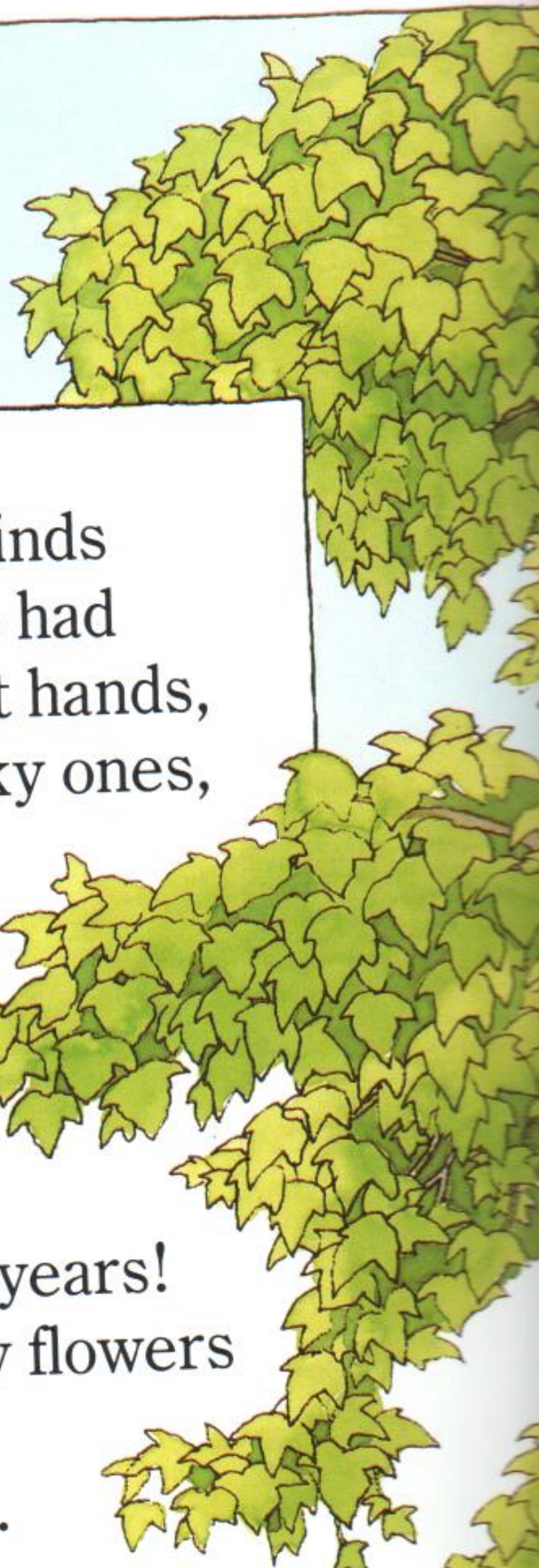
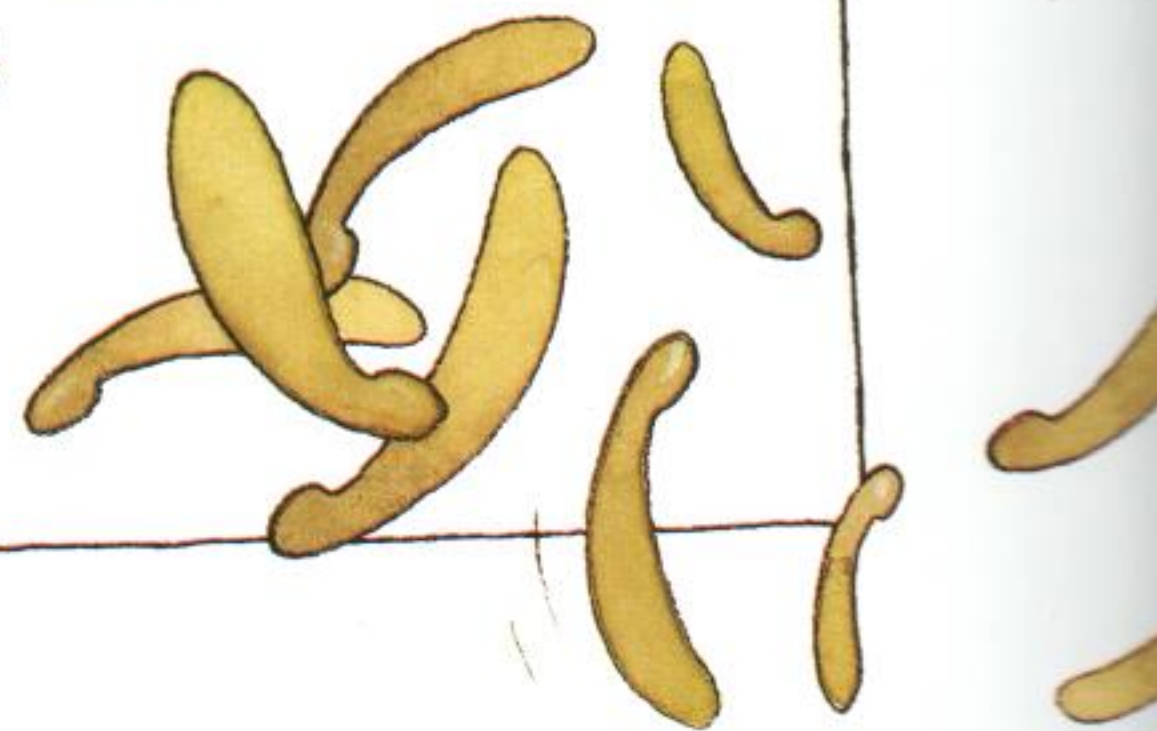
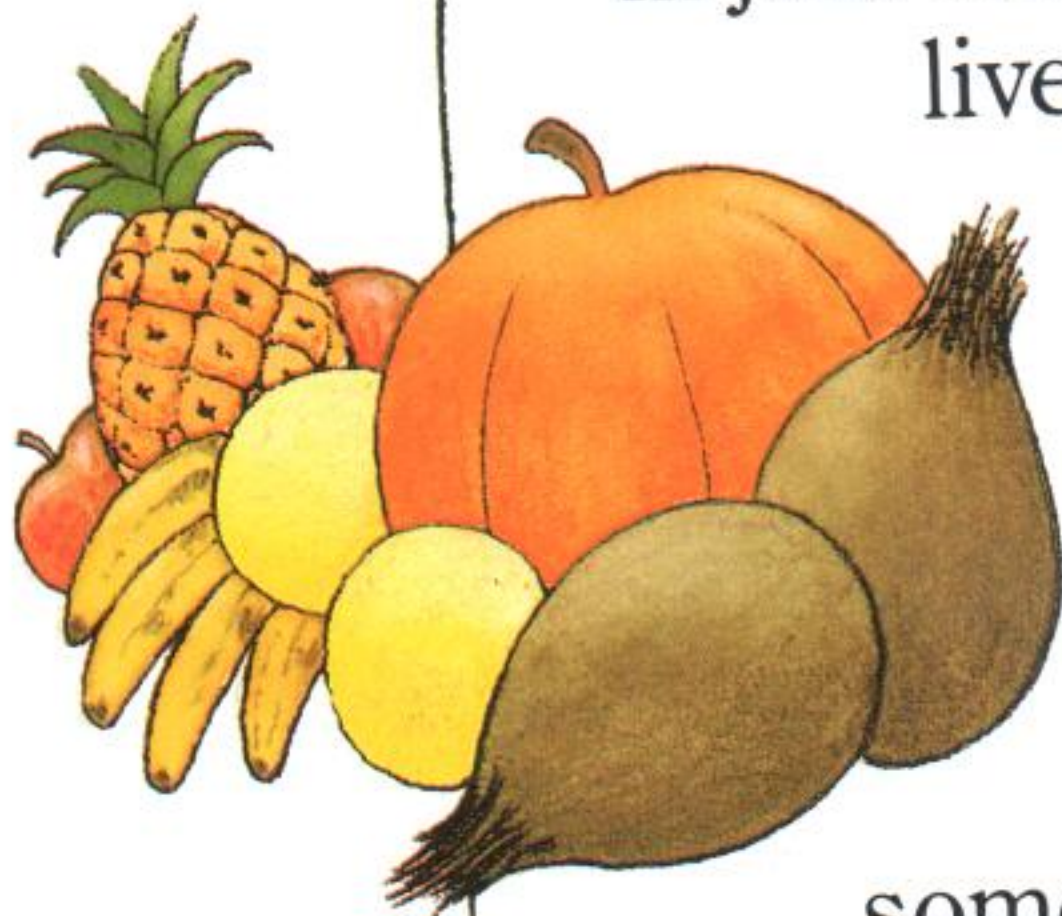


There were all kinds of plants. Some had leaves like giant hands, some had long spiky ones, some had small feathery ones and some had no leaves at all!
