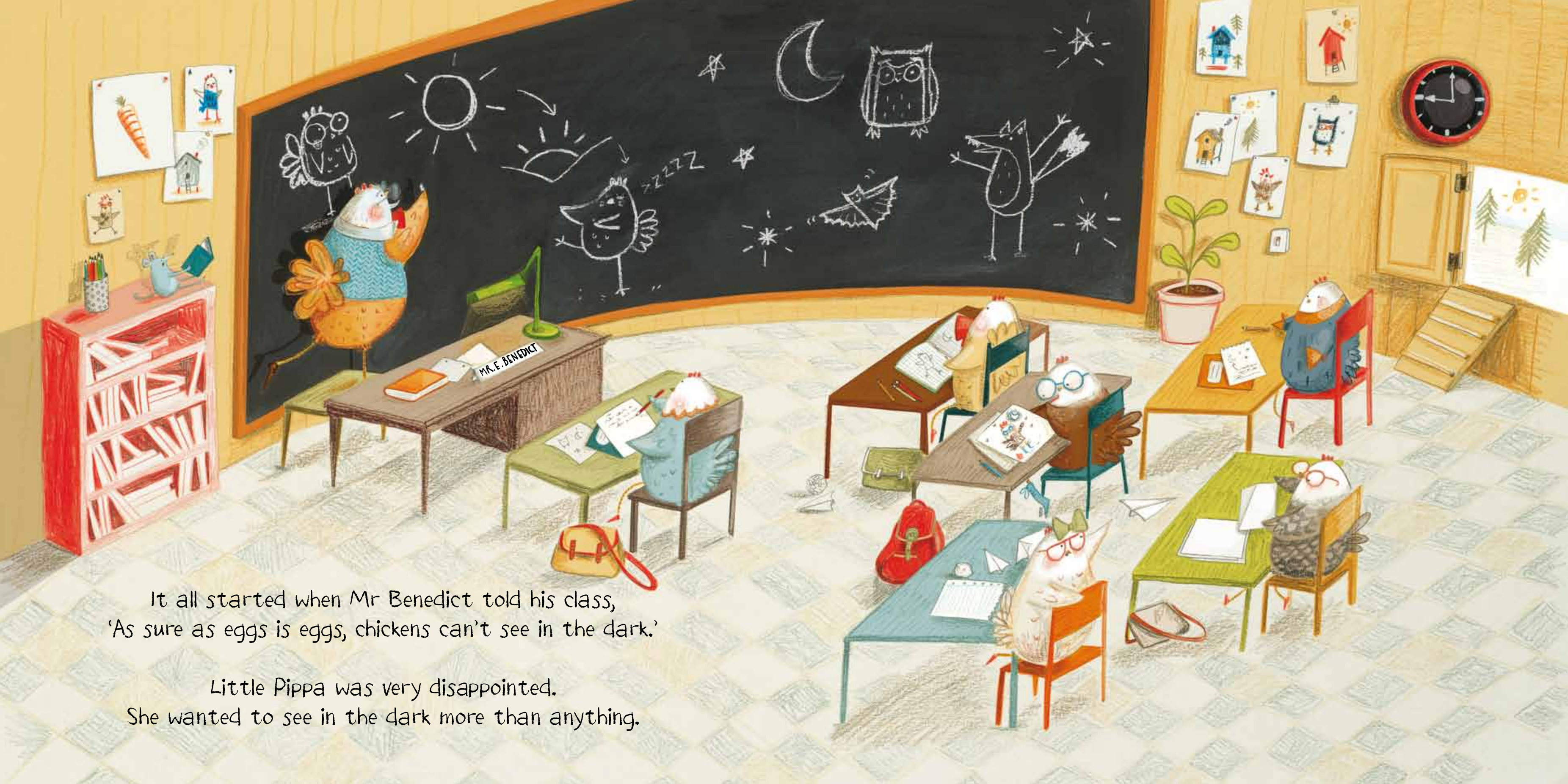

She wanted to see in the dark more than anything.



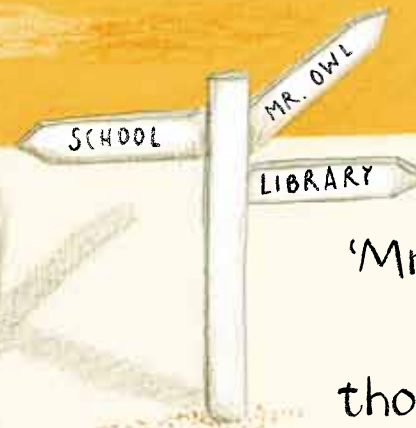
And she knew someone who might be able to help.
