plates **FULL** of succulent meat.



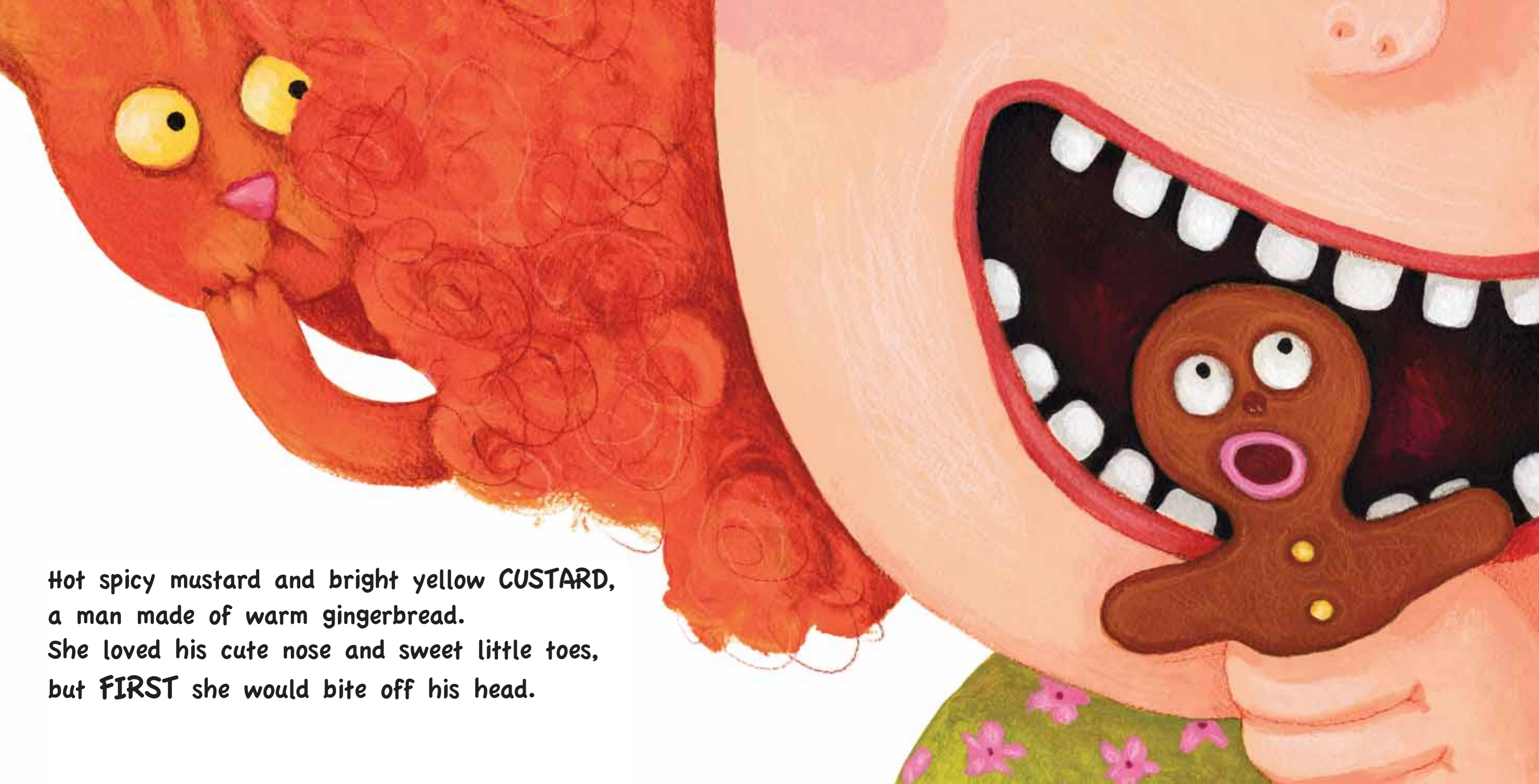


Bacon and ham, GOBBLED with jam,

even with WORMS inside.



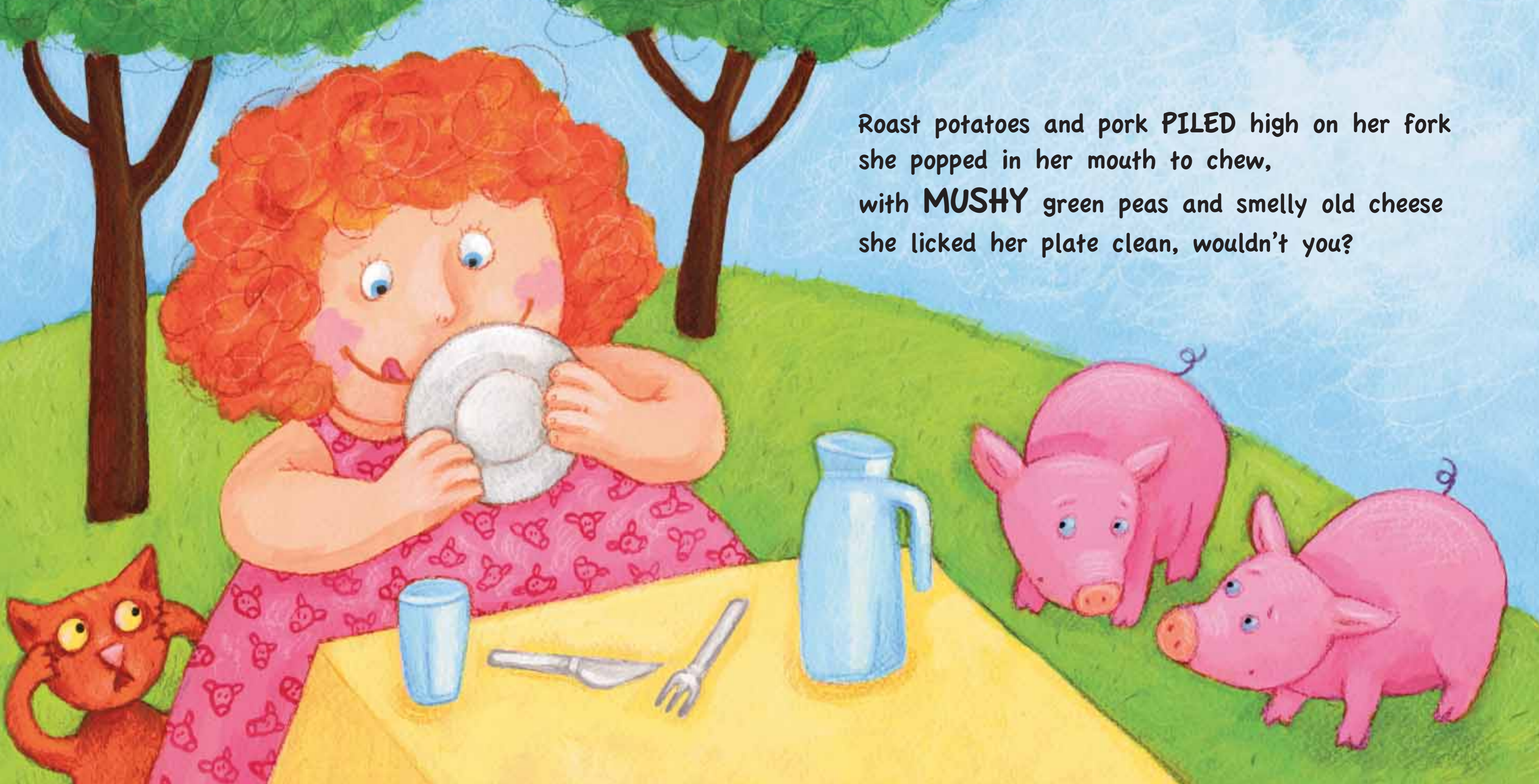
An indian curry she ate in a **HURRY**
