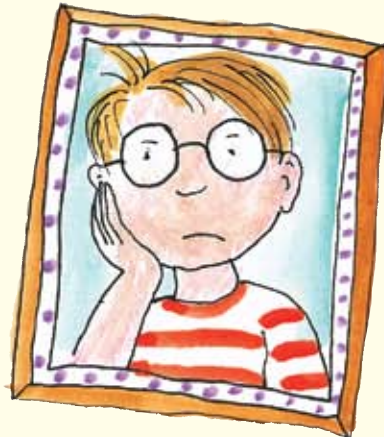
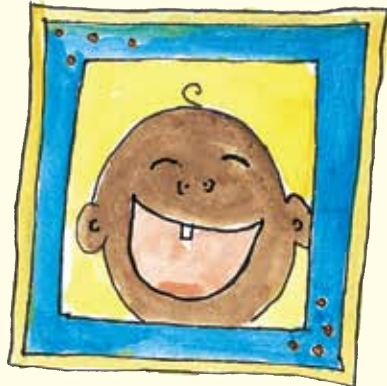

HAPPY

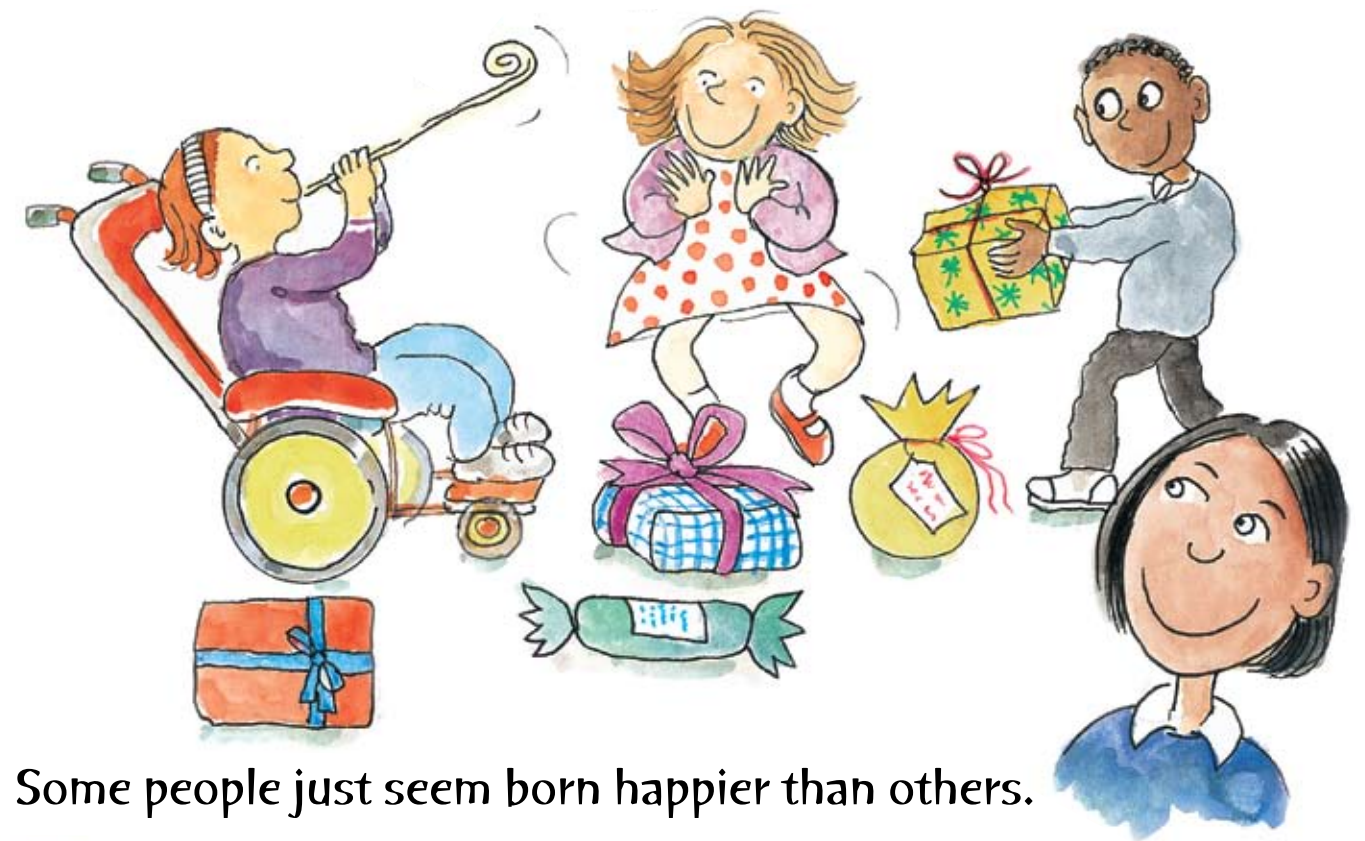
What makes you happy?

Some people just seem born happier than others.

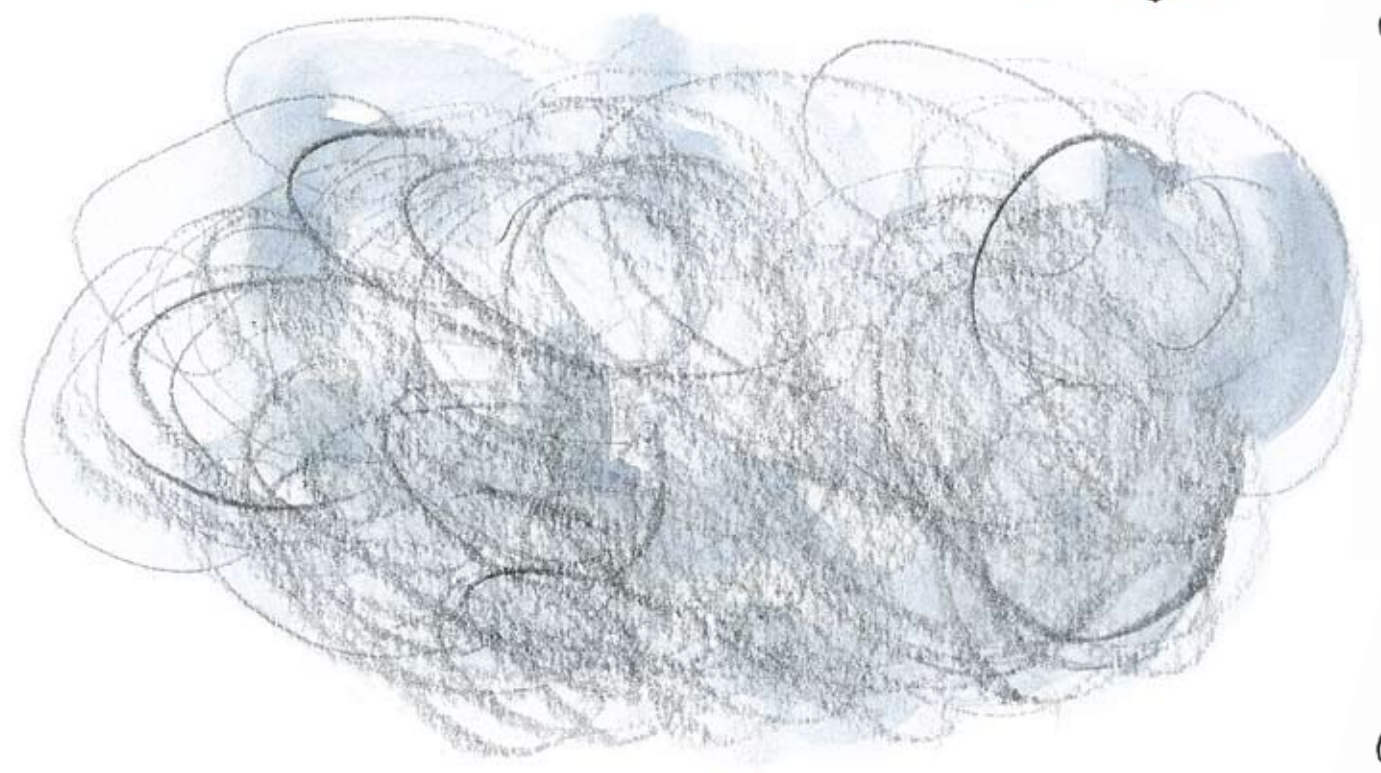


And it can be enough for the sun to be shining to make you feel very happy.

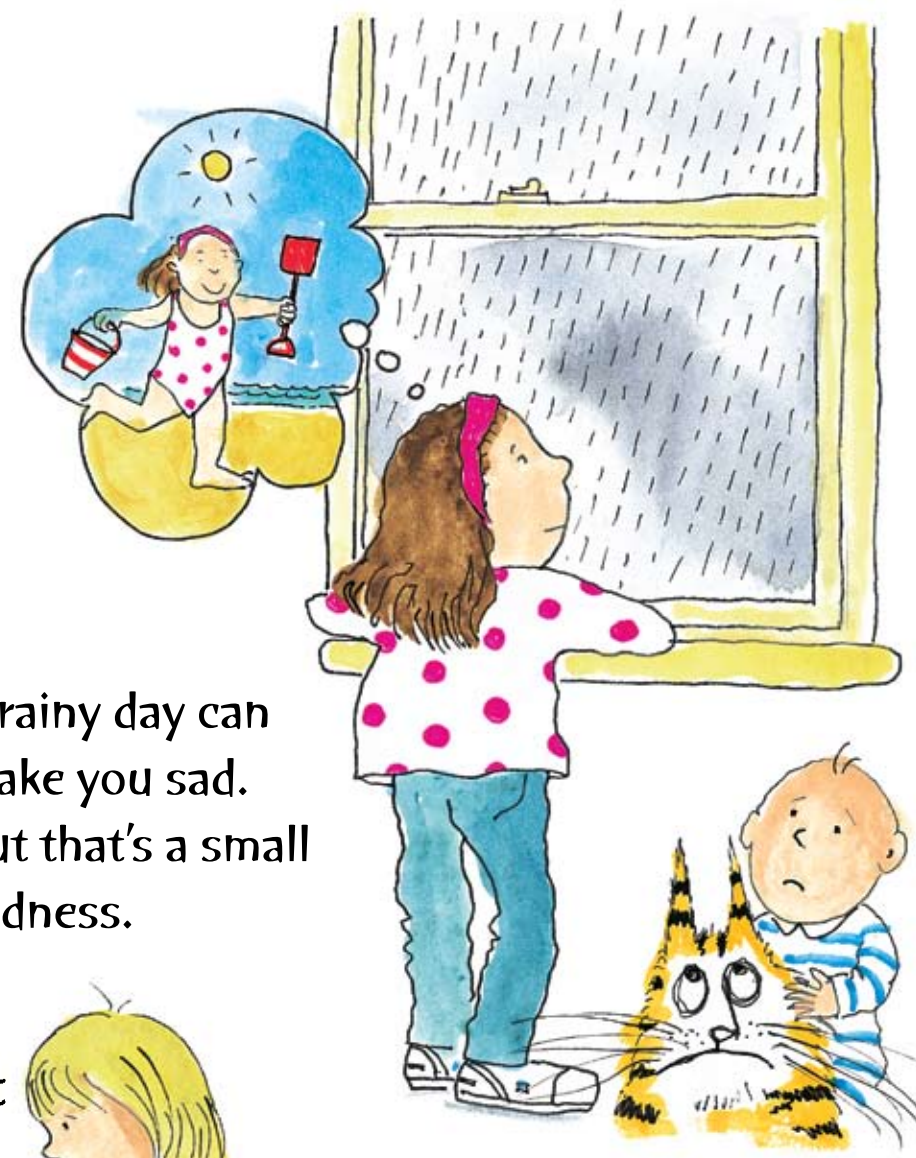
SAD

What makes you feel excited?

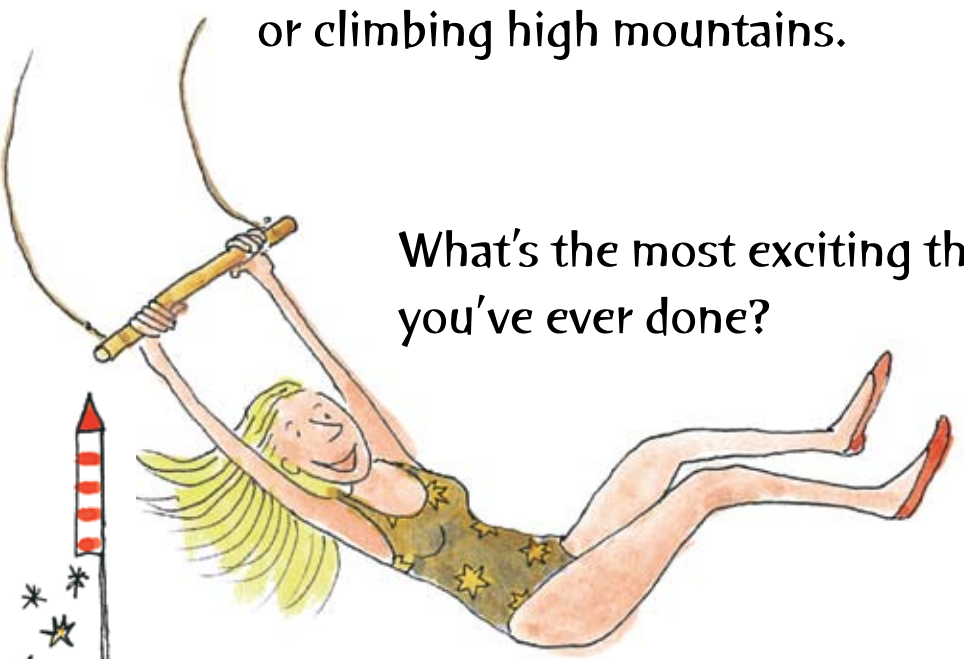


We can get very excited just about going on an outing.
