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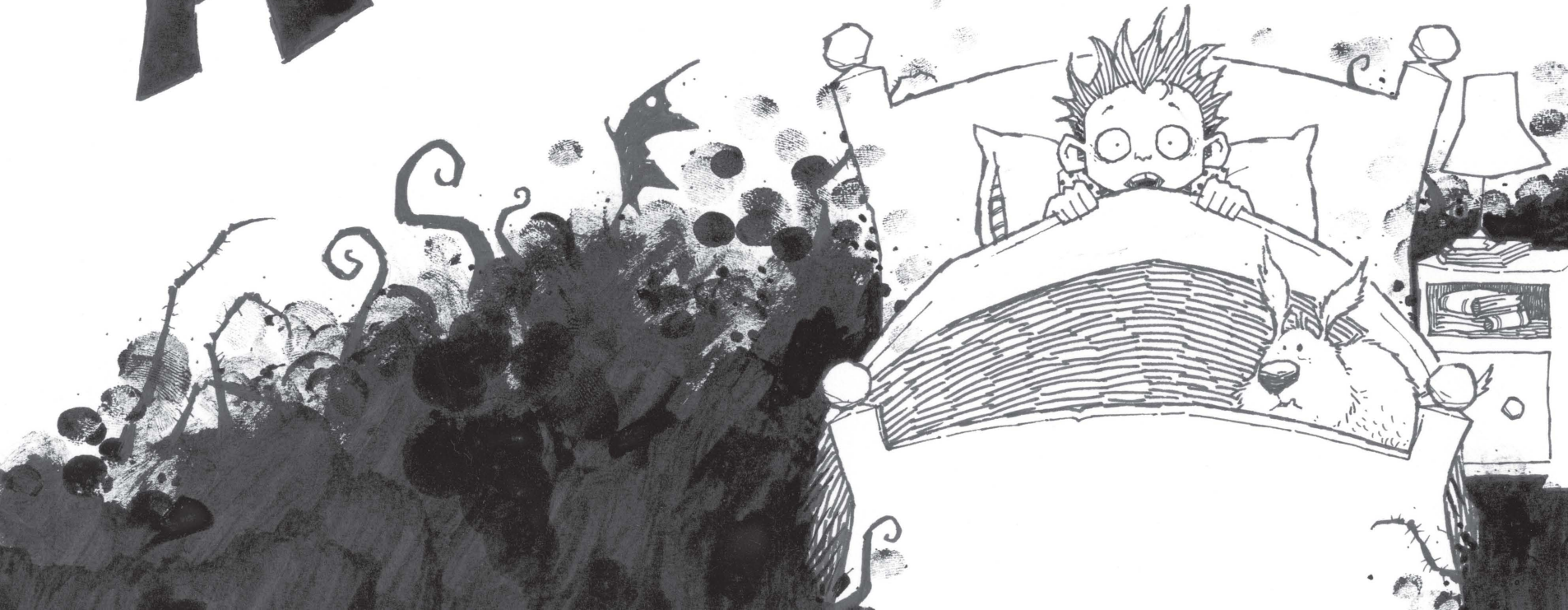
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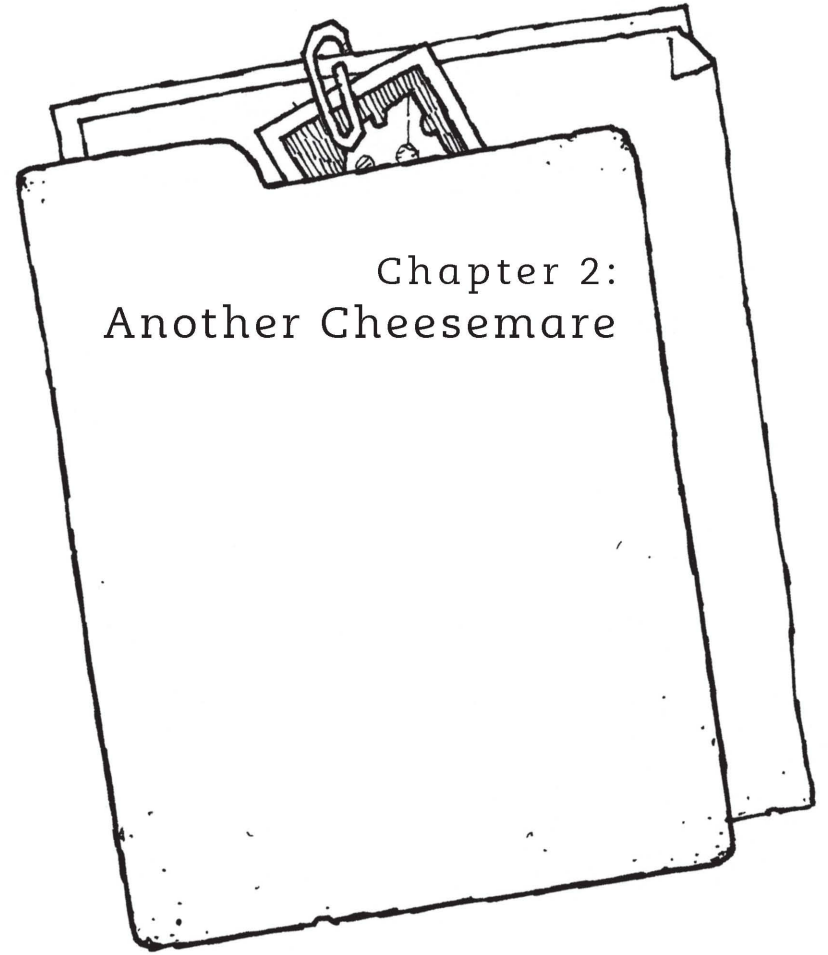

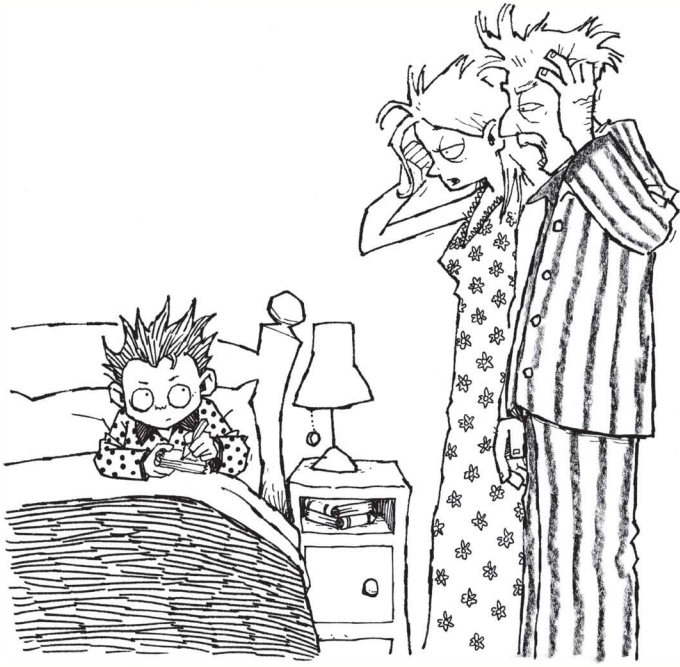

Another Cheesemare

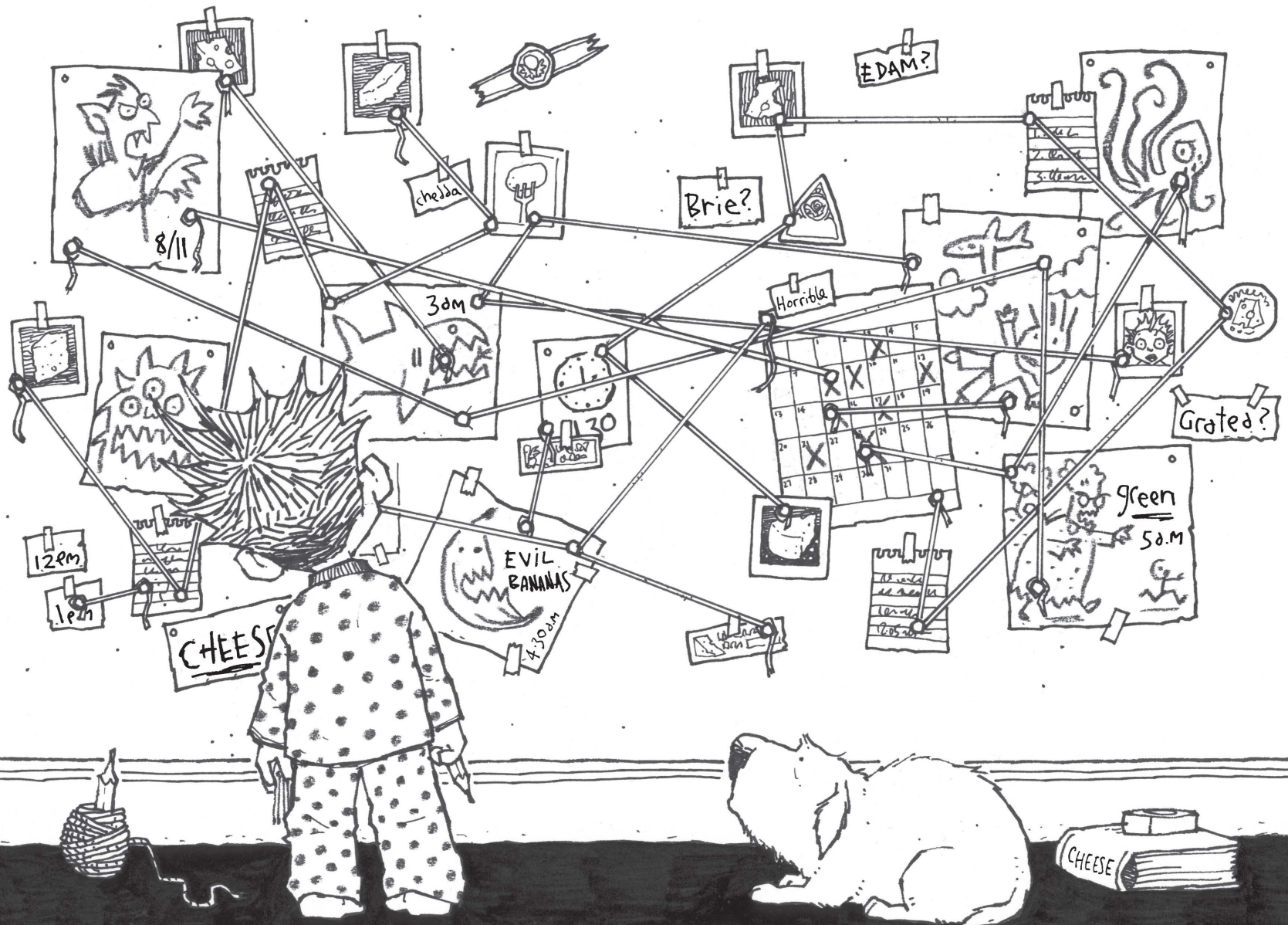
“Was it another bad dream?” asked Hal’s mum. “A nightmare?” asked Hal’s dad with a yawn.



“No,” said Hal. He picked up his pad and pencil. “It was another **cheesemare.**”

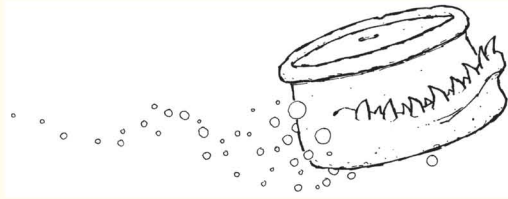

It was true. Hal had been sure for weeks that there must be a link between his cheesy snacks and the nightmares he kept having.

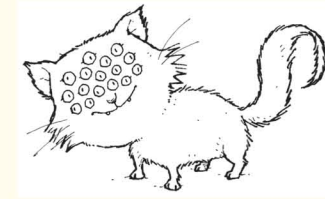


Hal first spotted the link the night he ate some smelly French cheese and had a horrible dream about vampires with poisonous cowboy boots.
