But Melvin is not impressed.







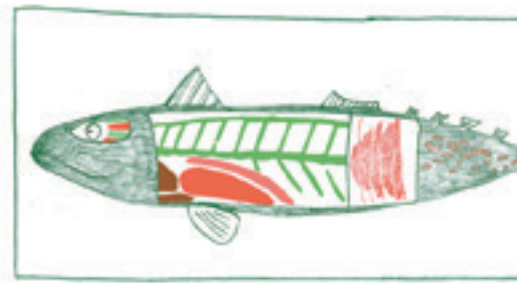
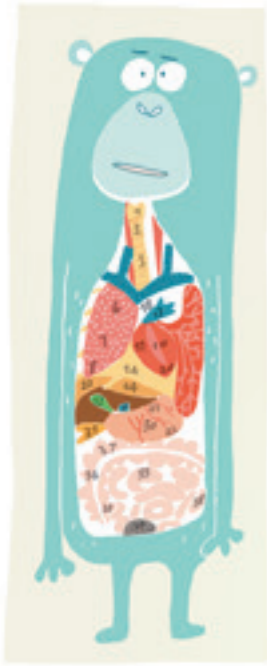
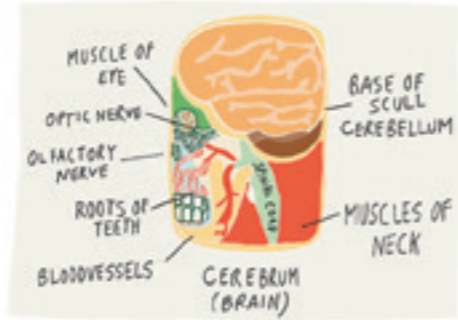
'There must be something wrong with me. Everyone is looking at me.'
