chomp-chomp



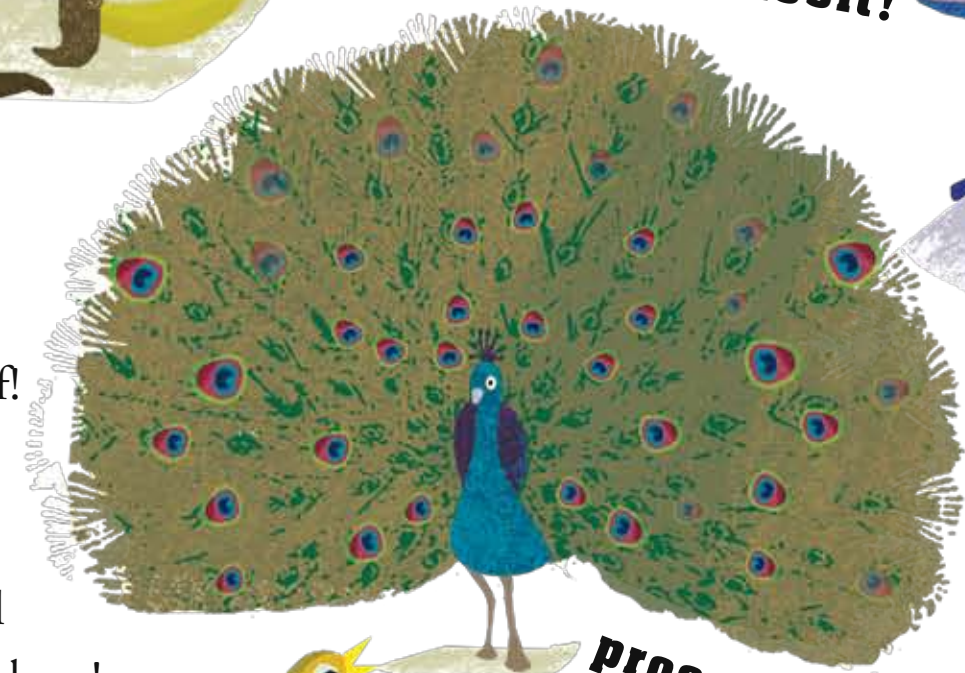
Velvet-black bats swoop through the night air.

Red-bottomed baboons stand out in a crowd.

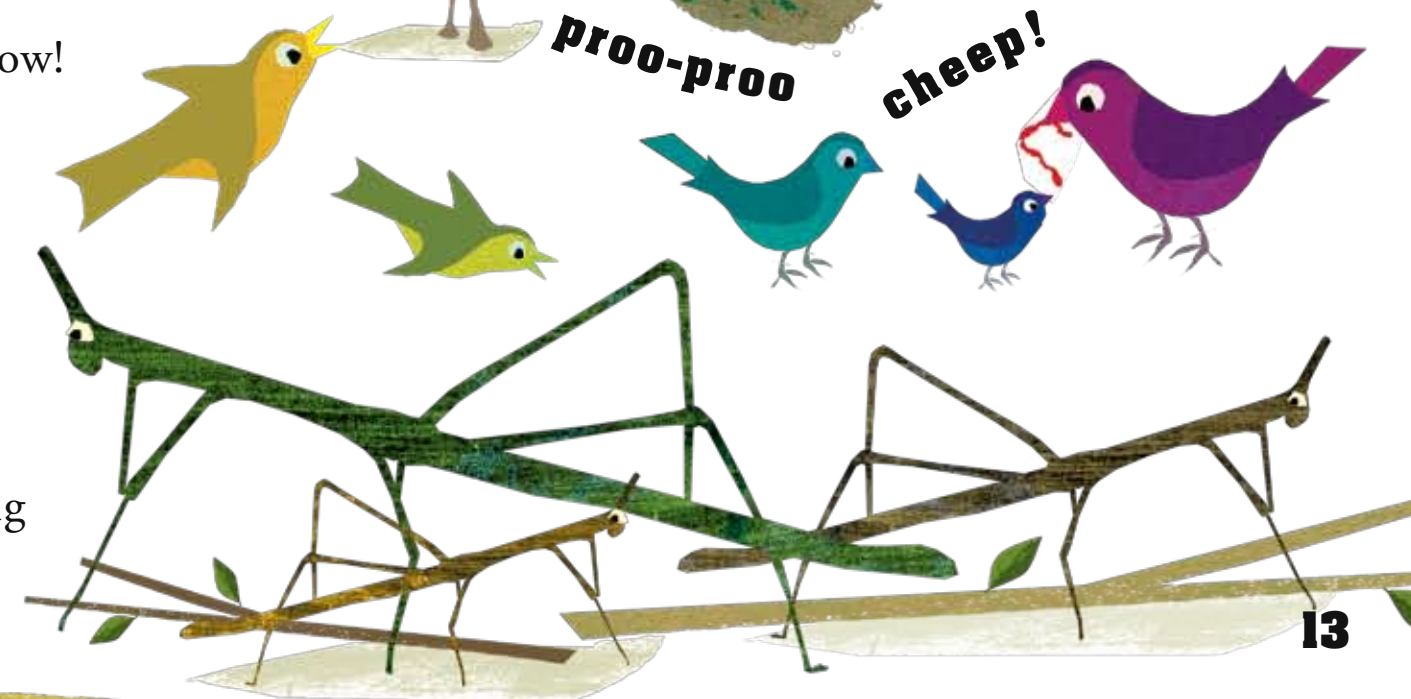


A peacock has eye patterns on its tail feathers. What a show-off!



Birds come in all colors of the rainbow!

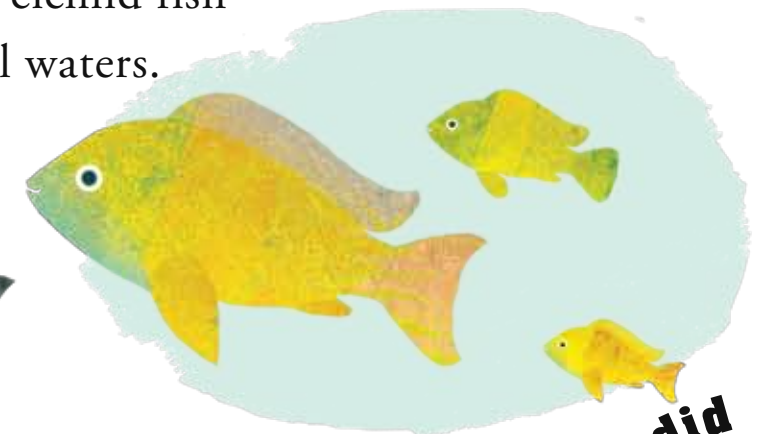
A walking stick is brownish green, just like a stick. How many walking sticks can you see?

kaatydid kaatydid



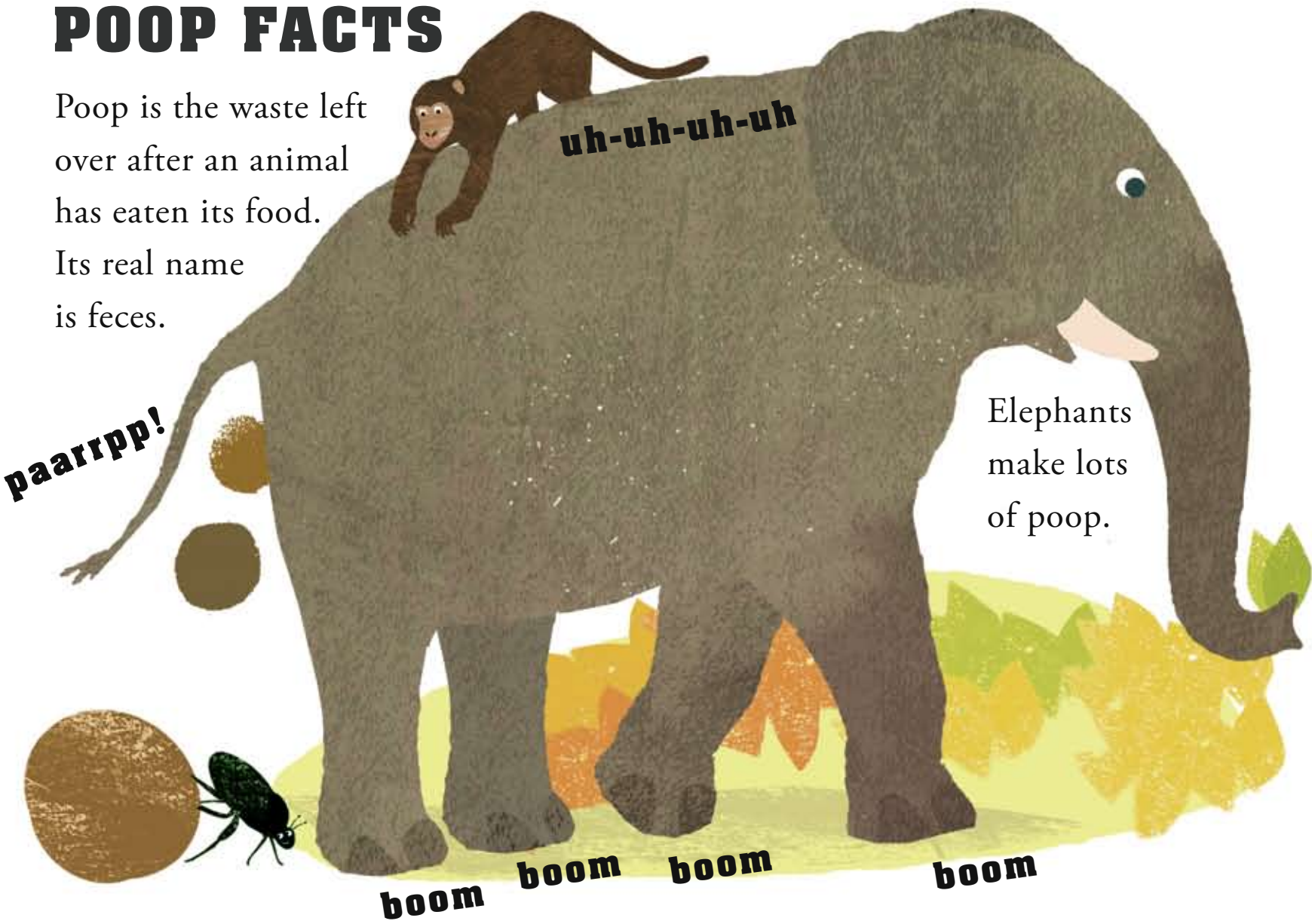

Elephants make lots of poop.

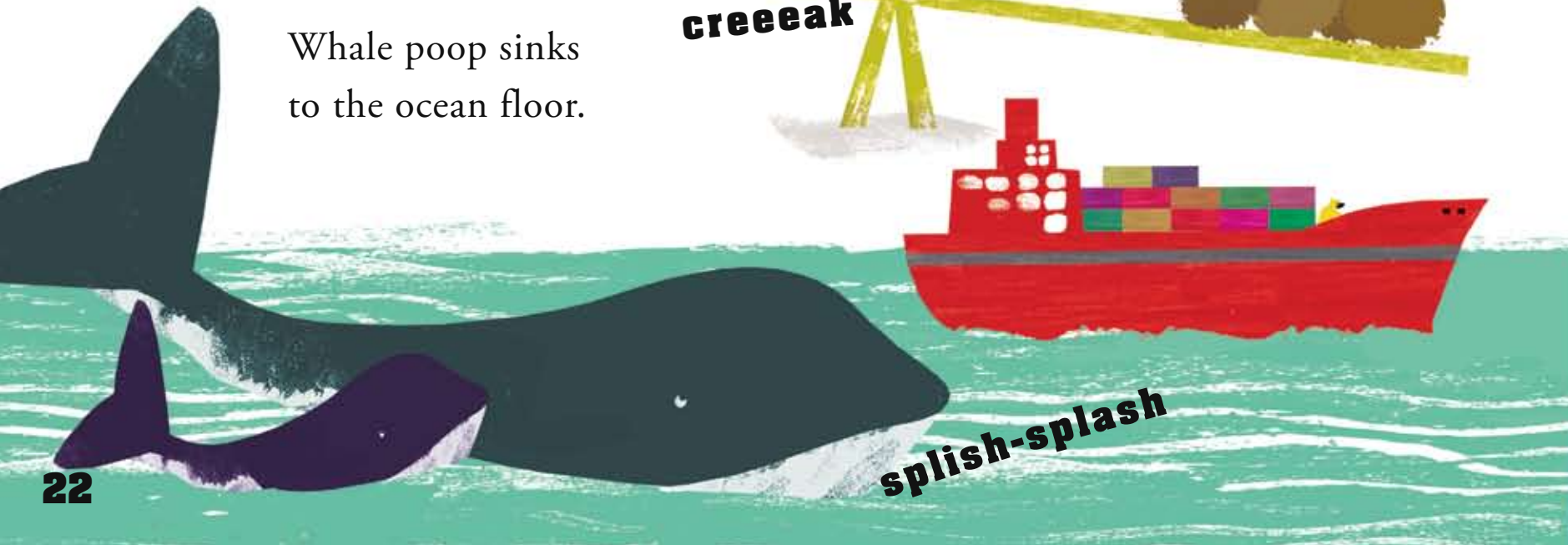
Dung beetles roll it away to lay their eggs in it, and they eat it!

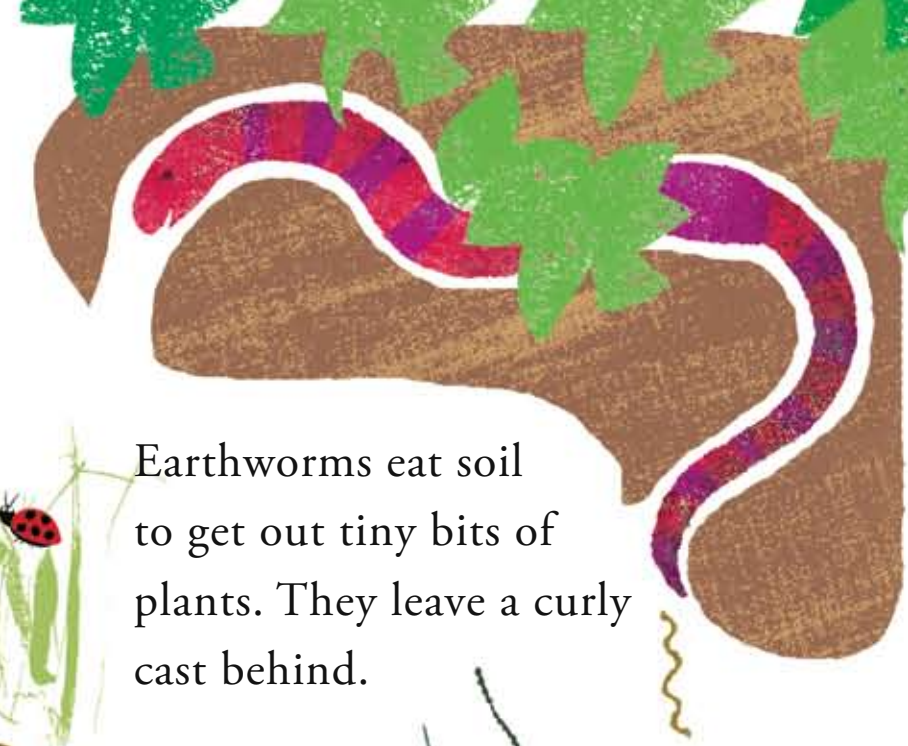
Whale poop sinks to the ocean floor.

BIGGEST AND SMALLEST

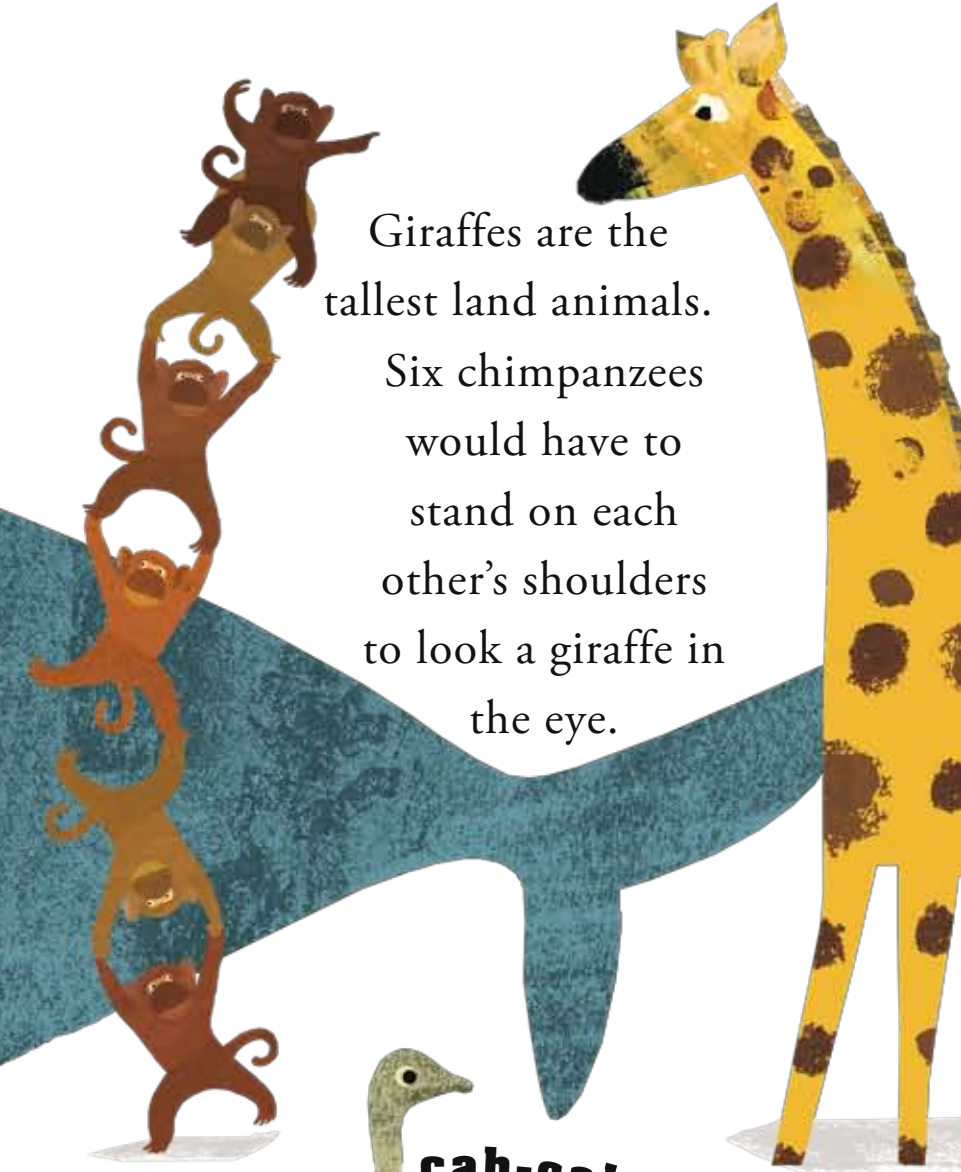
The biggest animal in the world is the blue whale. It is as long as 39 people lying down head to toe.

Giraffes are the tallest land animals. Six chimpanzees would have to stand on each other's shoulders to look a giraffe in the eye.

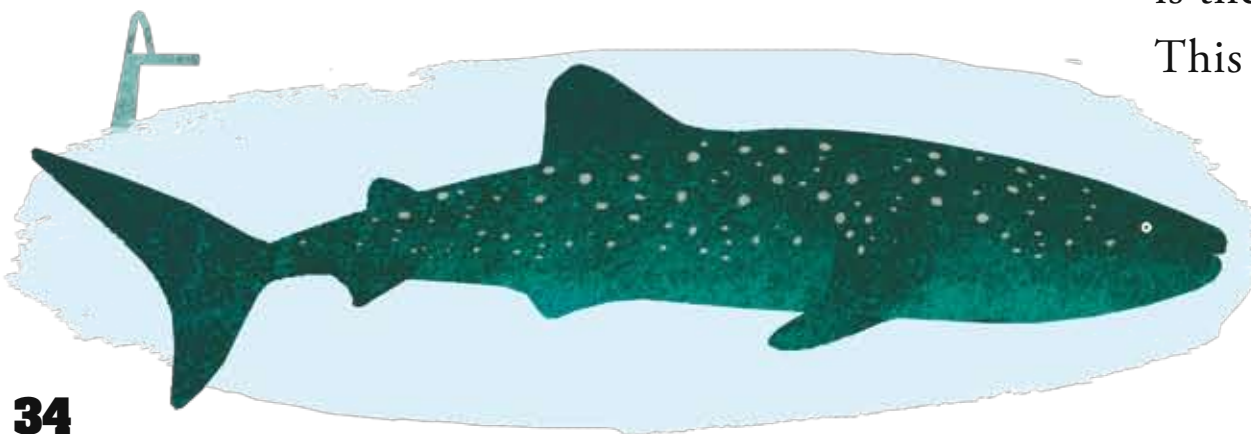

The smallest mammal is the bumblebee bat. This is its real size.



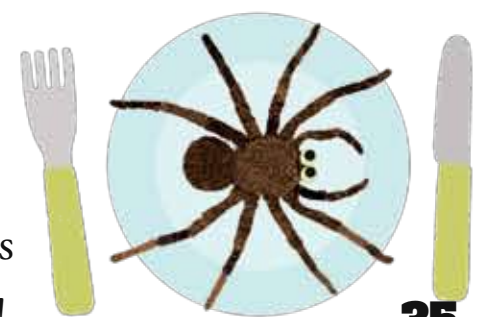
The whale shark would need a fish tank as big as a public swimming pool.
