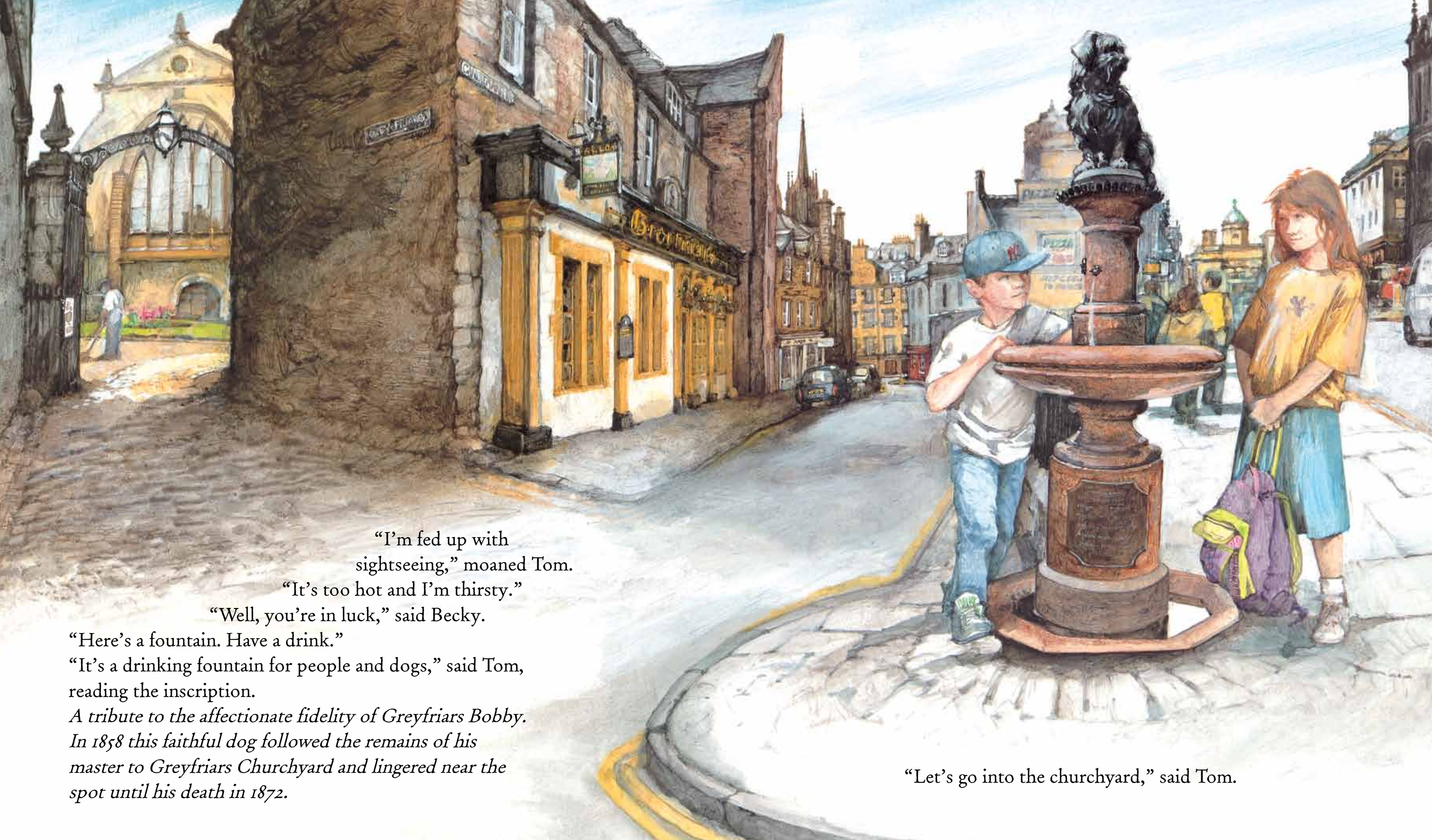

“It’s too hot and I’m thirsty.”

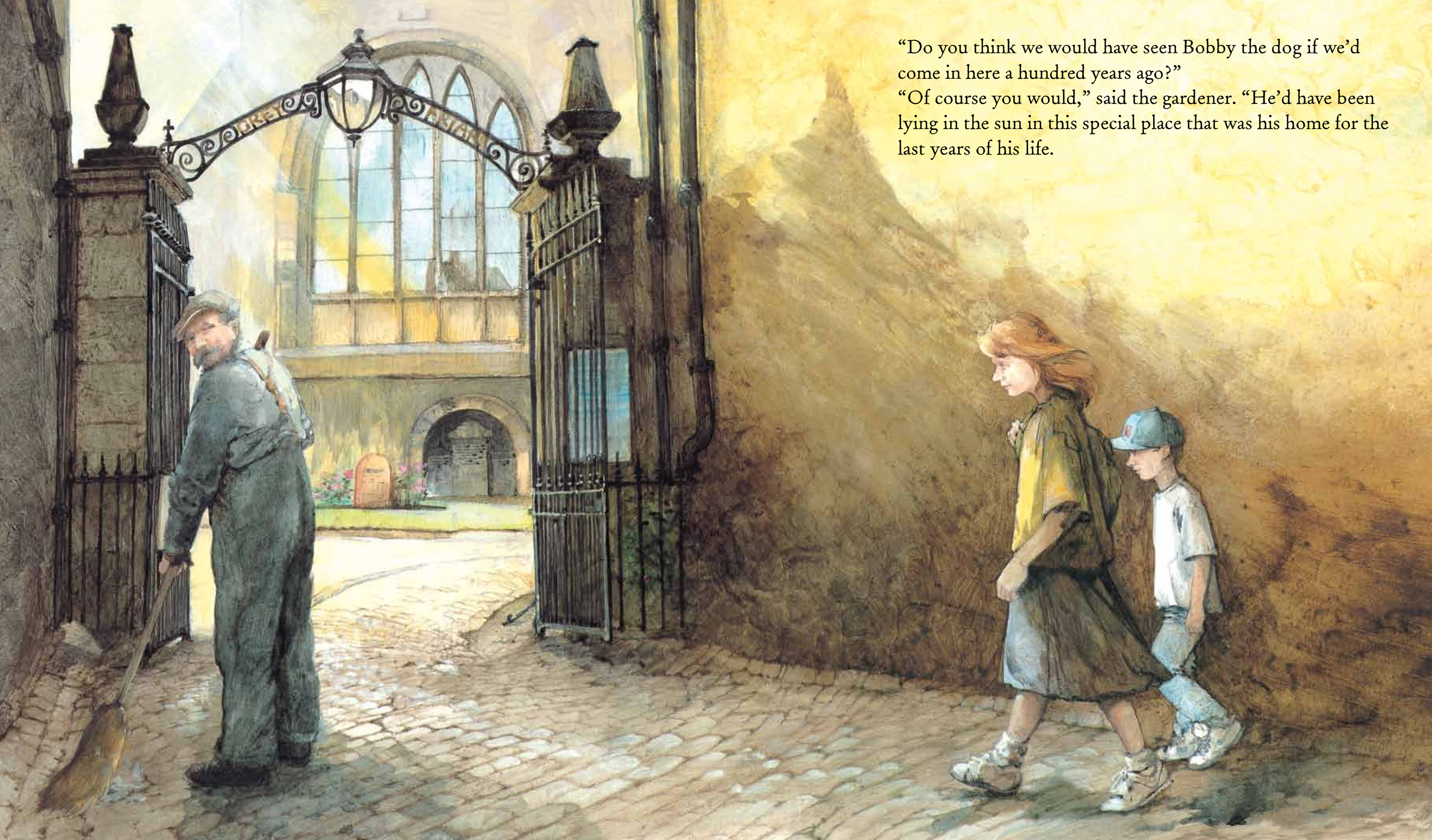
“Well, you’re in luck,” said Becky.
