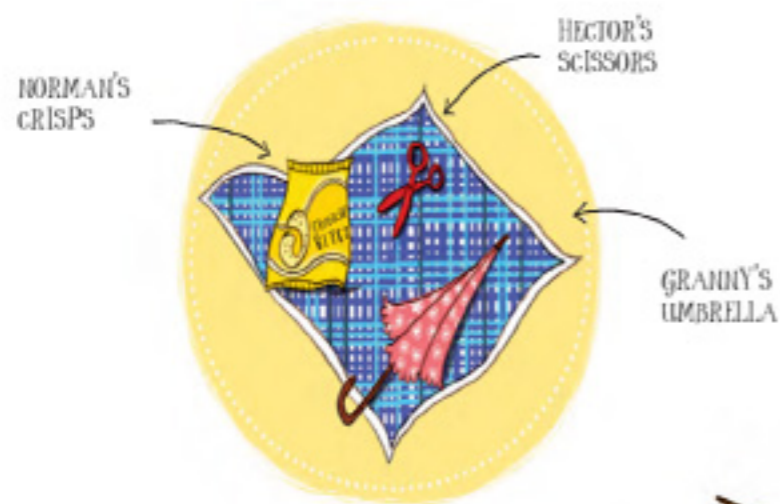

...and he trotted off to the moat.

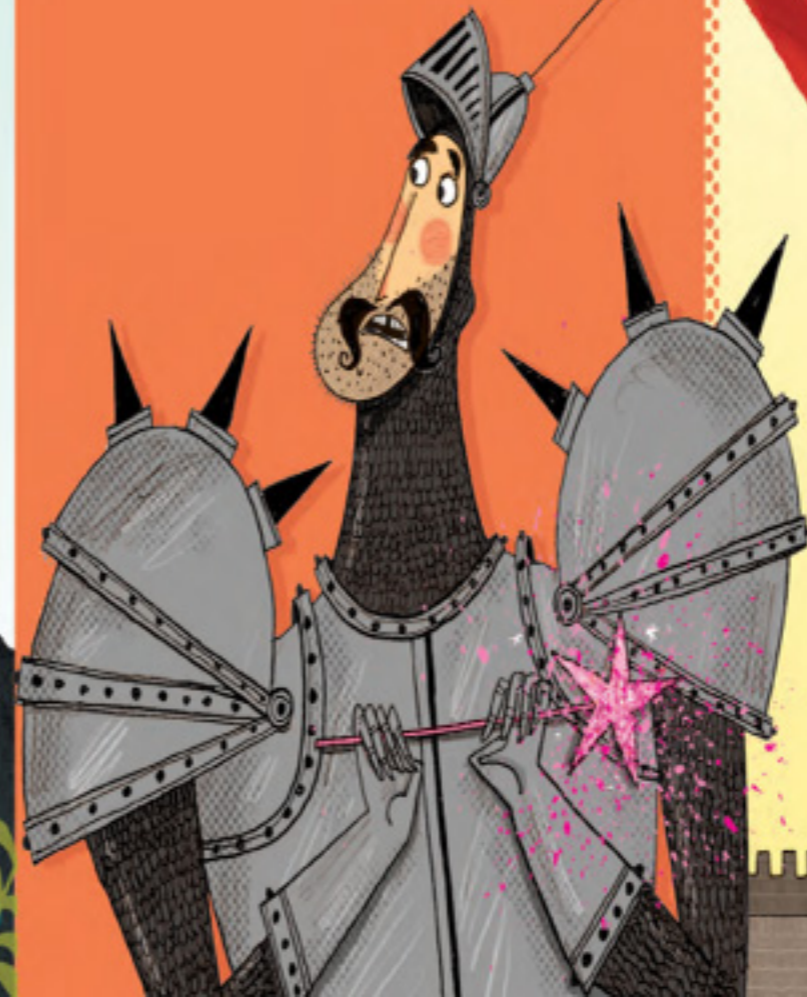
