2 Skippetty bunnies

These are very sweet... and very easy to make.



1 Copy the body and head shapes from the back cover onto plain card. Cut them out to use as templates.



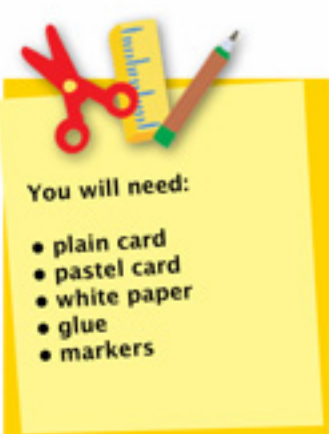
2 Fold a piece of pastel card for the body and match the template to the fold. Draw and cut out the body.



3 Draw around the head piece on a single piece of pastel card. Cut out. If you wish, cut inner ears in white paper and glue them on.



4 Draw the face with markers and then glue the head in place on the body.



You will need:

- plain card
- pastel card
- white paper
- glue
- markers
