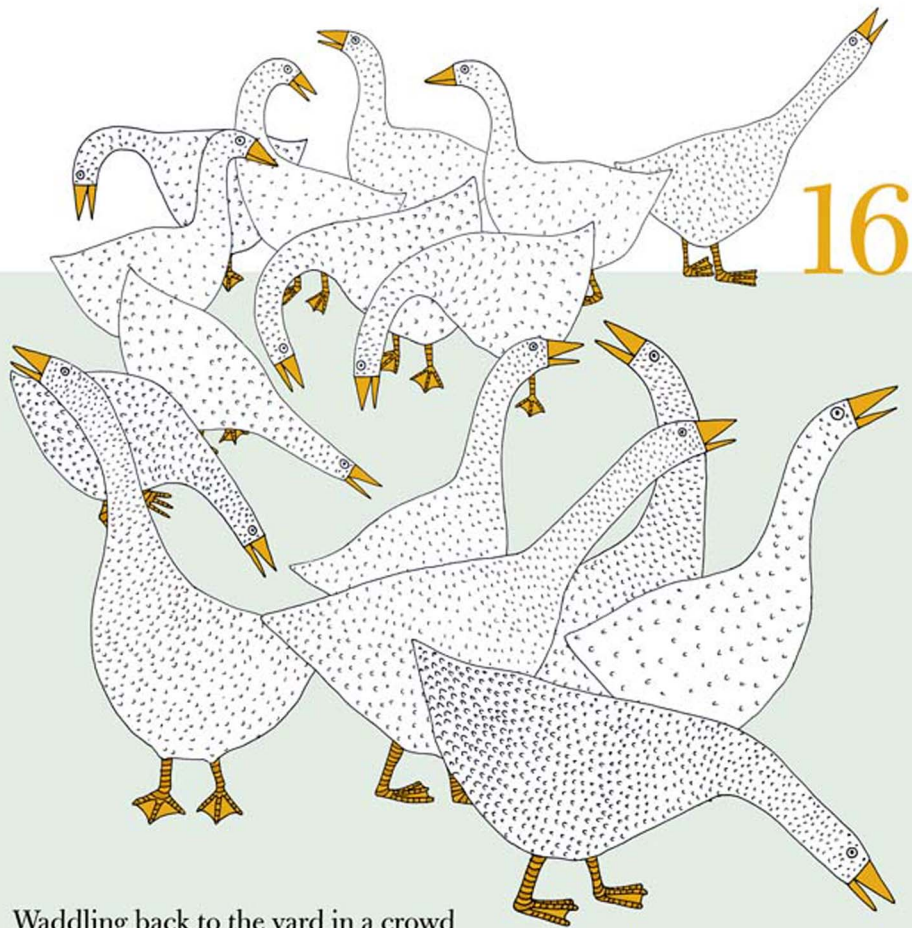


Another young baby is sleeping in bed whilst five wooden birds gently turn overhead.
